The Olde Virginia Rally was held the weekend of June 12-15 at Chippokes State Park in Surry County. Twelve Airstreams (20 adults and two children) rallied together. The weather was a little warmer than normal but, except for a rained-out campfire, the festivities proceeded per schedule.

On Friday morning we visited the R.M. Felts Packing Company, a producer of traditional dry-cured and smoked Virginia Country Ham in Ivor. What a fascinating and detailed view of the traditional process to dry-cure ham with salt (see pictures). This is how it was done in Olde Virginia before refrigeration. Many thanks to the folks at Felts who were so generous with their time. Really great folks. Many hams and bacon slabs left Ivor that morning in the back of our pickups!

On Saturday morning, after a breakfast of Country Ham and biscuits, we toured the oldest brick domicile in North America, Bacon's Castle. A plantation house built in 1665 (!). it is maintained by Preservation Virginia along with many outbuildings including slave quarters. After the tour, we helped weed and straighten up the house's formal garden for an hour. It seemed like a long hour in the heat, but our Airstreamers are tough and we persisted (see pictures).
