

The rally will take place in Enderby, BC at Riverside RV Park and Campground, 112 Kildonan Avenue, Enderby. Check out their website.

To short-list:

It is a nice quiet grassy campground that's within walking distance to town. The Riverwalk is a beautiful concrete trail hugging the river, that gets you to town in 10-15 minutes. Lots of unique shops, restaurants and nearby attractions. Like an awesome bakery and ice cream parlour close by. Mable Lake Golf course is 30 minutes away, as well as Salmon Arm, which has more unique shops and another golf course. They also have a sani-dump right on site.

Also, washrooms with hot showers, wifi, and a covered area with picnic tables if the weather is inclement for our happy hour. For those hikers in our group, there is a strenuous hike up to the Enderby Cliffs, awesome view when you get there! There are switch backs but very steep in areas. You'll need poles!! For those that bike, lots of quiet backroads, or the Rail Trail goes from Vernon to Lake Country (Oyama).

I've reserved 12 sites, but they will only hold them until March 1st !!!!!
