Presidents Scoop




Earlier this year we conducted a survey for our SEMAC members to make sure we are delivering the experiences our members are looking for. Nineteen members responded, and here are the results:

- 83% follow SEMAC on Facebook, while 17% follow us on Instagram
- 90% say that SEMAC Rallies have the right level of activities and that SEMAC is offering the right amount of rallies and meet-up opportunities.
- 68% think that three nights is the right length for a rally, with Four nights getting the second most votes at 26%.

- Here are the areas of Michigan that members are most interested in rallying at:
- 80% of respondents are interested in a local caravan, similar to what was offered in 2024. (we have something cooking for 2026 stay tuned!)



- Over 50% of respondents are interested in helping to plan a rally in the future!
- Other feedback we received included:

It is rewarding to get this positive feedback from our membership, and it lets us know that we are on the right track.

We need your help to approve an update to our constitution. Every 5 years ACI provides some proforma changes to be implemented, and this is the year. The board has reviewed the changes and they are non-substantive and mostly improved language for clarity. We need 60% of members to vote affirmatively to pass this. Please check your email (and spam/junk folders) from July 8, and look for an email from SEMAC Secretary, It contains links for you to review the proposed constitution and a link to vote. We need all votes in by July 22, please!

A Special Business meeting has been scheduled for August 5 at 7:00 pm for purposes of voting for the constitution amendments. If you vote electronically you do not need to attend the meeting. Details of the meeting dial in will be sent closer to the meeting date.

Do you love Airstreaming? Do you have an opinion? If so, serving on the SEMAC board may be right for you! Ask any of us who have served or are serving on the board, and they will tell you it has been a fun and rewarding experience, and not much work at all! We meet approximately 5 times a year, mostly via Zoom or at a rally. Setting out on an anticipated trip with the Airstream, all packed up and eager to arrive to my destination. But always in the back of my mind, and I am sure, all of our minds, is "What if". What if the tires on the rig blow, what would I do.

Traveling up to Wilderness State Park in Carp Lake, Michigan, I was enjoying an early Friday drive straight up I75N. Two hours away from the park, my truck's tire pressure monitoring system started to alert me. My mouth went dry, my stomach flipped, and I froze mentally for about 20 seconds. My truck rear passenger tire was losing air.

I pulled onto the right-hand shoulder, well into the grass, luckily there was field I could pull onto and be out of the way of traffic. I put my hazards on and sat and collected my thoughts. I put in a call to Ford roadside assistance. But with a two hour wait, I decided to google the nearest tow company to me. I called Sunrise Side Towing, in Sterling.

The man on the phone was calming and reassuring. With in 10 minutes they had a tow truck there. I had driven through glass of all things, and that started the air leaking out of my tire. The driver told me that the prior evening, a rv rolled over and apparently the road crew did a poor job of

cleaning up the debris. I was a very minor casualty of the poor clean up.

I always tell myself, it could always be worse. The driver put air in my tire and I followed him to their business just two miles away, with my heart thumping, as I was watching my TPMS to make sure I would make it. Sunrise Side Towing put on a new tire and had me on the road within 20 minutes. All of the staff were friendly and calming. It helped me relax and realize all is well.

It wasn't a blow out, my rig tires were fine, and it made me have gratitude for the lesson that day, that it was a minor situation and I, my pets, truck, and Airstream were all okay. Be safe in your travels!
