

Cypress Glenn Campground Brooksville, FL Nov. 13-17, 2025

Cypress Glen Campground is one of three campgrounds at Silver Lake near Croom, Florida (east of Brooksville). It is part of the Withlacoochee State Forest that surrounds the Withlacoochee River South.

Cypress Glen and Silver Lake campgrounds are both located next to Silver Lake, which is a wide spot in the river. The water is prime for kayakers, paddle boarders, and fisher-people. On the southeast end of the lake, the Withlacoochee River is narrower and it is a very scenic place to paddle.

Adjacent to the campground is the Withlacoochee State Trail, a 45 miles long paved rails-to-trails path that traverses three counties (Citrus, Hernando, and Pasco) (pictured below). Access to the bike path is about a ½ mile by mountain bike or ¾ mile on the road bike to the "snowbird" gate. Click here for a map of the trail.

There will be a kayak group and a bike group doing those activities. We are in the state forest, but groceries are nearby. Dade City Brew House is also nearby. Tentative agenda is below. More details to be announced later.

Reservations are made at www.reserveamerica.com You should go there and make reservations if you haven't already. The other RV campground is called Silver Lake Campground. If you can't get into Cypress Glen, try Silver Lake Campground. After you have secured your campsite, then register for the rally at https://airstreamclub.org/florida/rallies-and-events. Cracker Christmas & Installation of Officers Fort Christmas, FL Dec. 4-8, 2025

Every December, something magical happens in the little town of Christmas, Florida—and we're not just talking about twinkle lights and hot cider. We roll into town, bringing our signature silver trailers, big hearts, and a whole lot of holiday cheer to the Cracker Christmas Festival at Fort Christmas Historical Park. During the festival, we learn about the early traditions of Florida and the cracker cattle the Spanish brought over.

This isn't your average craft fair. Picture over 100 crafters, demonstrations by blacksmiths, musicians, and more, pioneer cabins, kettle corn, all while Airstreamers in boots help bring it all to life! For over 25 years, we have volunteered at the festival—directing traffic, lending a hand with freshening up the homes, educating visitors about the historical homes, or just adding a dose of that classic Airstream spirit to the mix. It's also our officer installation for the incoming volunteers (Thursday night Dec. 4), because what better backdrop can we find than a historic fort decked out for the season!

It's more than just a meet-up. It's a chance to give back, soak up some Florida heritage, and roast a marshmallow or two with friends who feel like family. Whether you're a seasoned streamer or a first-timer, this shiny tradition proves that Christmas is always better with Airstreams—and a little Country Cracker flair.

This is a volunteer, public service rally, so half of each day is volunteering for the fort and the other half is having fun with your friends. We also provide a nice dinner in a historical schoolhouse for the installation of next year's officers.

It is "semi-boondocking" with shared water and shared electricity (less than 10 amps per guest) so bring a long water hose with Y adaptor and 50 feet extension cord with 20 amp Edison plug.
