





Our rally is just around the corner Eric and I want it to be a relaxing comfortable time filled with great company, food and fun. We want it to be a great end of camping season for all.

Space is limited to 12 units. It is a boondocking rally so make sure you have topped off your water, propane tanks and your grey and waste tanks are empty. We will be parked on a farm field so grey water can be allowed to empty slowly by using a termination cover hose attachment with a garden hosed attached. There will be Port-a-Lav on site and generators are allowed without time restrictions.

Note: This type of waste tank cover allows for a hose to be attached to the drain your grey tank away from the trailer so there isn't puddling at your site.

The rally fee will be \$30 per person.

If everyone attending could please email or text me to let me know what day you are arriving and leaving so I can plan food, and activities. The rally is planned from Thursday the 9th to Monday the 13th, for anyone who has Columbus Day off.


