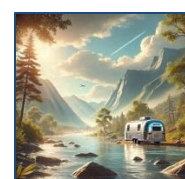

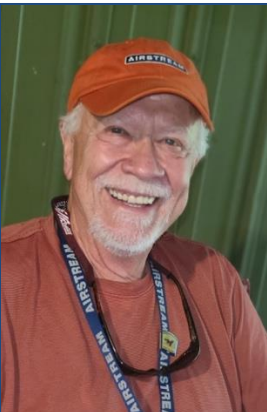

Our Adventures in Floyd submitted by Bill & Sandee Welch (BRN 01399)

When my husband Bill asked if I'd like to visit Floyd, I asked "Who's Floyd?"

Well come to find out, he was actually referring to the town of Floyd! This quaint, historic locale is nestled in the heart of Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains. Only 40 minutes from Roanoke, Floyd is part of Virginia's "Crooked Road," a musical heritage trail that winds through Southeast Virginia.

Traditional bluegrass and old-time mountain music can be enjoyed at a variety of venues around town. One of the favorite spots is the Floyd Country Store. Every Friday night they host a "jamboree" that includes live music and the chance, should you be so inclined, to do a bit of dancing. You'll also find musicians playing and singing at various spots along the main street.

Other fun music venues include Wildwood Farms where on weekends throughout the year you can hear bluegrass. At the Buffalo Mountain Brewery from Thursday thru Sunday evenings, you can not only enjoy a great craft beer but also you can listen to music from incredible local groups.

While visiting Floyd, you can look forward to shopping at locally owned boutiques and artisanal galleries and dining at unique cafes and farm to table restaurants. Plus, every Saturday morning throughout the year you can enjoy perusing the stalls of the downtown Farmer's Market.

Nearby, there are wineries to visit and local farms to tour. You can even stop by the Mabry Mill, one of the most popular and recognized landmarks of Virginia's Blue Ridge.

An excellent place to stay is the Floyd Family Campground. The views are stupendous. They offer full electric, sewer and water hookups, with some sites only having water and electric. They also have cottages and cabins available for rent just in case you want to bring along someone who doesn't have an Airstream or RV.

So, if you are looking for a place to hear some bluegrass/mountain music, shop and dine or you just want to enjoy the peace and tranquility of the Blue Ridge Mountains, then you'll want to put Floyd on the list of small Southeastern towns you should visit!

Crockpot Chicken and Noodles

Ingredients:

2 cans of cream of chicken soup

(or mix or match with 1 can cream of chicken, or 1 can cream of mushroom, or cream of asparagus or onion)

4 cups of chicken broth or bone broth

3 to 4 chicken breasts, skinless

Season chicken with pepper, garlic powder and onion powder to your liking.

Add fresh or dried herbs (parsley, thyme, rosemary,) anything you prefer.

3/4 to 1 bag of egg noodles

Instructions:

Add all ingredients to a crockpot except egg noodles.

Cook on high 4 hours (low 6 hours)

Remove chicken, let cool, shred and place back in the crockpot.

Then add 3/4 to 1 bag of egg noodles.

Cover and cook another 45 minutes to an hour until egg noodles are done.

Perfect for fall camping!
