Feb. 29 - March 4: Sun Outdoors Central Coast Wine Country RV Resort, Paso Robles.

Escape to the majestic rolling hills and celebrated wineries of Paso Robles. Located midway between Los Angeles and San Francisco and bordered by coastal Highway 1 and the 101, Paso Robles is California wine country with beach access and Michelin stars. A community of cowboys and innovators, it's where world-class food, wine and art meet small-town charm.

Paso Robles is Central California at its best. Wine tasting tours, hot air balloon rides, award winning dining, museums and Hearst Castle await! And the RV resort is top drawer. It has everything you can want in a resort, including heated pool, hot tub, fitness center, dog park, playground, and more.

April 4 - 8 Guajome Regional Park, Oceanside

Guajome (pronounced wah-ho'-may, or gwah-ho'-may) is a Luiseño Indian word that translates to "frog pond." And indeed, there are a couple of ponds in this Regional Park that have fish and, no doubt, some frogs. This destination, in the valley east of Oceanside, has a more natural, and less developed, ambiance with many shade trees around the sites. It has 4.5 miles of bike and hiking trails through diverse Southern California habitats such as woodlands, chaparral, wetlands and mixed grasslands.

Of course, this Regional Park is close to the coast with nearby shopping, dining, and many San Diego attractions, including San Diego Zoo Safari Park and LegoLand. This is a popular RV park that sells out most weekends many months in advance.

May 2 - 6 Flying Flags RV Resort, Buellton

This is another wine country, Central California, resort. It has shady pull-through and back-in sites, two pools, spas, play grounds, nearby dining, and more. Plus, going off-site, there is nearby Avila Beach, equestrian trail rides, Ostrichland U.S.A., the Hans Christian Anderson Museum, and did I mention wine tasting tours? In other words, a First Class RV resort that you will want to return to.
