From the Editor

Just a couple of random observations that may be of interest to the membership. . .

Mobile Internet Service I know that I am a little late to the party, but others may not have discovered a truly effective way to stay connected to family, friends, work, and have access to all your streaming services at home. For a recent birthday, my son bought me a Starlink Mini kit for when Nancy and I head out in our Airstream. I have used it on three outings now, including the mountains where there is no cell service, and I can tell you that it works as advertised.

The flat antenna is about the size of a sheet of paper and can run off of 110 volt a.c., or a 12 volt power bank or cigarette lighter outlet. It has an internal modem and beams its signal wirelessly to your phone, pad, computer ot smart TV. With it I can make telephone calls without cell service, and watch video from my home streaming services.

The kit currently sells for \$299 and they have plans starting at \$50 per month for roaming service that you can activate and deactivate by the month. I am very satisfied by the service, convenience, and peace of mind.

Battery Check

I made a recent discovery regarding my Airstream's battery bank. Ours was about three years old and we had two 100 watt hour AGM (lead-acid) batteries that came with the rig when we bought it. We keep our trailer at our home and plugged into shore power to keep the batteries charged, ready to go. All was well for about two and a half years, but when we arrived at a dry camping spot in Anza Borrego, I disconnected the Airstream from my truck and checked the voltage inside the trailer. All I had was 12.2 volts.

Normally, when fully charged, I would get around 13.2 volts, and with AGM batteries, you are told to not discharge them to less than 50 percent. Using the formula provided, that meant I was supposed to stop using my batteries when they got below 12.1 volts. Normally, with my two roof solar panels, it could easily meet the needs of my Airstream. But starting at 12.2 volts meant there was something wrong with my system.

With the refrigerator and ceiling fan running, power quickly dropped to 11.8 volts, even with full sun on my panels. If it dropped much more than that, serious damage could occur to the electrical devices that require 12 volts (it eventually dropped to 11.4 volts).

The trip was not jeopardized because I brought our gasoline generator to run the AC, and used it to charge up the batteries while we engaged in some serious power conserving measures. But when we returned home, I discovered that one of my battery's cells had failed, compromising the entire system. I took the opportunity to upgrade to two 100 watt hour lithium iron phosphate (LiFePO4) batteries, which deliver about double the energy of AGMs, recharge more quickly, and weigh much less.

But here is the lesson I learned. If you always keep your trailer plugged in, you will not know if your batteries have failed until you get to camp. Before heading out, you should test your system by unplugging it a few days before to check to see if it is holding a charge. If not, you have time to diagnose and fix the problem.


