

Peach Mango Salsa

Ripe peaches, diced
1 ripe mango, diced
1/4 cup red onion, finely chopped
1/4 cup fresh cilantro, chopped
1 jalapeño, seeded and minced
1 tablespoon lime juice
Salt to taste



INSTRUCTIONS


In a medium bowl, combine the diced peaches and mango.

- Add the finely chopped red onion, chopped cilantro, and minced jalapeño.
- Drizzle with lime juice.
- Gently toss all ingredients together until well combined.
- Season with salt to taste.
- Serve immediately or chill for later.

NOTES

- For a milder salsa, remove all seeds and membranes from the jalapeño.
- Adjust the amount of jalapeño to your preferred spice level.
- This salsa pairs wonderfully with tortilla chips, grilled chicken, or fish.

Airstream Nuts & Bolts:

Top 10 Tips & Tricks to Winterize Your Airstream By Melia Jacobs

As the leaves turn and the chill creeps in, it's time to prep your beloved Airstream for winter. Whether you're storing Airstream for the season or planning frosty adventures, winterizing is essential to protect your rig and keep it road-ready. Here are my top 10 tried-and-true tips from the road:

1. Drain All Water Systems

- Start by draining the fresh water tank, gray and black tanks, and water heater. Use the low-point drains and make sure no water is left to freeze and cause damage.
- 2. Flush with RV Antifreeze
- Pump non-toxic RV antifreeze through your plumbing system to protect pipes and valves. Don't forget the toilet, shower, and outdoor shower if you have one!
- 3. Disconnect and Store Batteries
- Remove batteries from smoke detectors, clocks, and other devices. For your main battery, either disconnect it or keep it on a trickle charger.
- 4. Seal Vents and Windows
- Inspect all seals and weather stripping. Use vent pillows or covers to block drafts and prevent critters from sneaking in.
- 5. Clean and Dry Everything
- Give your Shiney Hiney a deep clean inside and out. Moisture is your enemy—leave cabinets and fridge doors slightly open to prevent mold and mildew.
- 6. Check Propane Systems
- Turn off propane tanks and inspect lines for leaks. Store tanks in a safe, ventilated area if not attached.

7. Protect Soft Surfaces

Cover mattresses and cushions with breathable fabric or remove them entirely. This helps prevent moisture buildup and mildew.

8. Lubricate Locks and Hinges

Cold weather can stiffen locks and hinges. A little lubricant goes a long way in keeping things moving smoothly.

9. Critter-Proof Your Camper

Seal any gaps and use natural repellents like peppermint oil to deter mice. Store food in airtight containers or remove it altogether.

10. Rally-Ready Even in Winter!

Even if you're not traveling, winter is a great time to plan your next rally. We're already dreaming of spring meetups.

Stay warm, stay safe, and keep those wheels ready to roll.
