Random observations that may be of interest to the membership. . .

Bicycle Racks

Nancy and I own a 2021 Bambi 20FB. We have a couple of raod bikes that we would like to take with us on our Airstream adventures. We have a bike rack that attaches to our truck's tow hitch receiver, but that is not available to us when pulling the Airstream. Bambis do not come with a rear bumper and when we bought our trailer I could not find a trailer hitch that could be installed on the rear of a Bambi. But I recently performed another Internet search for such a device and found one.

It is made by Torklift Central, and they make trailer accessory hitches designed for Airstreams, with or without the rear bumper.

I bought the one specifically made for the Bambi and it works very well. It is quite robust, well made (heavy!), and is integrated with the design of the trailer. The bolt-on installation (no welding) was moderately complex, with some cutting into the plastic skirt below the rear horizontal rub bar, but not too difficult for the average DIY'r (the included instructions were "advisory" in some stages - - possibly because Airstreams are somewhat hand built and differ in dimensions).

A Story from photo (in the frame):

A Tale of Three Porcelains: Tracing Gzhel and Delft Blue's Chinese Inspiration

The iconic blue and white designs of Delftware and Gzhel (ask Svetlana for pronunciation) pottery may seem worlds apart, yet they share a common artistic ancestor: Chinese porcelain. Delftware, hailing from the Netherlands, is celebrated for its intricate cobalt-blue paintings on white faience or porcelain—featuring detailed landscapes, floral vignettes, and ornamental panels. Royal Delft, established in 1653, remains a renowned producer of this cherished style.

In contrast, Gzhel pottery from Russia, which emerged in its recognizable form around 1802, embraces a more stylized and folk-art approach. With bold floral motifs and geometric symmetry, Gzhel exemplifies a uniquely Russian interpretation of the blue-and-white tradition, standing as a cultural emblem in its own right.

Both styles, though distinct in aesthetic and origin, reflect a shared inspiration: the delicate beauty of Chinese blue-and-white porcelain that captivated Europe and beyond from the Ming dynasty onward. Through Delft and Gzhel, this Eastern influence continues to echo across continents and centuries.
