How to Back an Airstream Like a Pro

Backing a travel trailer can be one of the most intimidating parts of RVing, especially if you're new to it. But with a few simple steps and one golden rule — **turn toward the problem** — you can make it look easy. The "problem" is whichever side of the back of the trailer is drifting the wrong way. Whether you're backing straight or into an angled space, that little phrase will guide every correction you need to make.

It's best to start by practicing in a straight line. As you back up, watch both sides of your trailer. If one side starts to wander off course, turn your steering wheel slightly toward that direction — toward the problem. With larger trailers, you may need to move the wheel between the 10 o'clock and 2 o'clock positions for small adjustments. Shorter Airstreams react faster, so minor turns to 11 o'clock or 1 o'clock are often all it takes. Once you're comfortable keeping it straight, try gentle curves, like following the inside line of a driveway.

When it's time to back into an angled campsite, the process involves **three main steps**: setting the angle, maintaining the angle, and straightening out. To begin, pull forward so your vehicle is close to the entrance of your site. As soon as your rear wheels pass the edge of the space, turn your steering wheel slightly toward the site to start creating the backing angle. Since the trailer will swing in the opposite direction, remember — the "problem" is on the far side, so turn the wheel harder toward that side to create the rest of the angle that will guide the trailer into the spot.

Once your trailer begins to turn into the site, focus on maintaining your angle with small steering corrections. You'll be turning both directions as needed to keep the trailer tracking smoothly. When it's time to straighten out, turn your steering wheel **toward the campsite** to bring your tow vehicle back in line with the trailer. If at any point your turn gets too sharp, don't worry — just pull forward a foot or two while turning the opposite direction. That small move can fix your angle and prevent jackknifing.

The best way to build confidence is with practice. A quiet mall parking lot with a few cones makes a great training ground — or if you're lucky enough to live in the country, a friendly neighbor's pasture works too. Backing an Airstream takes patience and practice, but once you get the feel for it, it becomes second nature. And if you run into a tricky setup or a tight campground, feel free to reach out — I'm always happy to help you plan your next perfect back-in.

Cypress Glenn Campground Brooksville, FL Nov. 13-17, 2025

Cypress Glen Campground is one of three campgrounds at Silver Lake near Croom, Florida (east of Brooksville). It is part of the Withlacoochee State Forest that surrounds the Withlacoochee River South.

Cypress Glen and Silver Lake campgrounds are both located next to Silver Lake, which is a wide spot in the river. The water is prime for kayakers, paddle boarders, and fisher-people. On the southeast end of the lake, the Withlacoochee River is narrower and it is a very scenic place to paddle.

Adjacent to the campground is the Withlacoochee State Trail, a 45 miles long paved rails-to-trails path that traverses three counties (Citrus, Hernando, and Pasco) (pictured below). Access to the bike path is about a ½ mile by mountain bike or ¾ mile on the road bike to the "snowbird" gate. Click here for a map of the trail.

There will be a kayak group and a bike group doing those activities. We are in the state forest, but groceries are nearby. Dade City Brew House is also nearby. Tentative agenda is below. More details to be announced later.

Reservations are made at www.reserveamerica.com You should go there and make reservations if you haven't already. The other RV campground is called Silver Lake Campground. If you can't get into Cypress Glen, try Silver Lake Campground. After you have secured your campsite, then register for the rally at https://airstreamclub.org/florida/rallies-and-events.
