President's Letter November 2025








Where is the Riveted Peach?





Dutch Oven Campfire Nachos

Ingredients

- •1 bag of tortilla chips (10-15 oz bag)
- •12 oz sharp cheddar cheese (shredded)
- •1 15 oz can black beans, drained
- •1 2 oz can sliced black olives (optional)

Topping Ideas:

- •tomato (diced)
- avocado (diced)
- cilantro (chopped)
- •green onion (chopped)
- •salsa
- •sour cream



Instructions

- •Get a campfire going and let it burn down for about 10 minutes, or until you have some coals in the fire.
- •In the dutch oven layer chips, cheese, beans, and olives: Spread a layer of chips on the bottom of the cast iron. Top with 1/3 of the shredded cheese and a couple of spoonfuls of the drained beans and olives (if using). Repeat this layering at least 2 more times. If using a 4 Qt. cast iron, you can fit about 3 layers.
- •Put the lid on the dutch oven and place it near (but not on) the fire. Carefully put 1-2 coals under the dutch oven, and 4-5 coals on the lid. See the video for a demonstration.
- •After 10 minutes, carefully use a fire glove or lid lifter to check on the nachos. The cheese should be melted. If not, add fresh coals to the lid and wait a few more minutes before checking again.
- •Once the cheese has melted, remove the dutch oven from the fire pit and carefully add your toppings. Serve immediately.

Polar Bears & Northern Lights Caravan Alan & Sherry Johnson

September 14-October 14, 2025

Our group of 20 Airstreams started out in Carberry, Manitoba on a potato farm! A multi-million dollar 20,000 acre farm whose potatoes become McDonald french fries.

We visited a canola farm that had a transplanter almost as wide as a football field.

We picnicked on a small farm with pigs, bison & chickens, riding in a cattle trailer to the bison field. Did you know that when a mother bison has twins, she doesn't understand and will leave one of them behind. This happened to this farmer, so he adopted the forgotten twin and now the baby bison follows him everywhere., and still does to this day (and is not a baby anymore). The farmer doesn't only raise bison, he has hogs, sows with lots of piglets, and closer to his house were his chickens, roosting in an old yellow school bus.

We visited a honey bee farm, watched logs get made into planks, enjoyed a homemade Ukrainian feast while watching young people dance in colorful costumes.
We colored fresh eggs using the pysankarstvo method, hot wax.

In the evening, we retired back to the campground with a campfire, music, and later on a clear night, we feasted on the northern lights.



All this was before the grand finale of riding in a train overnight to Churchill, Polar Bear Capital of the World, and 850 year-round inhabitants. One can only get there by airplane or train. We spent two nights in a tundra hotel on wheels. They can't build on frozen ground, While we were there we hunted polar bears. Hungry polar bears migrate to Hudson Bay during the fall to hunt for seals. We saw two bears. One, we were able to track for 2 days.

After visiting all the polar bear and First Nation museums, we finished our Churchill excursion with a dog sled ride called Ididamile. Afterwards we caught the overnight train back to civilization.

We finished our caravan in Winnipeg, Manitoba's capital, exploring all it had to offer, too numerous to list. We finished tired, but excited. Not only had we gotten to know Manitoba, but we had adopted a new family of fellow adventurers. We celebrated, exchanged personal information, and vowed that our paths would cross again.

This one is definitely one for the bucket list.
