Propane Regulator Leak - lessons learned

Helpful Hint! after setting up my rig, I proceeded to turn the propane on and I smelled gas leaking and determined propane was leaking out the top of the regulator . After dealing with multiple places here and in Livingston. I found CWS propane not 5 miles from here. They were really helpful and always keep multiple types of regulators in stock. The man showed me how to replace and even gave me a roll of Teflon tape....

The best thing I learned is to always have the selector knob pointed to a tank. He told me I should not be bouncing down the road with the selector knob in the middle.....he said that's what probably caused my failure.....I had someone tell me



that it was ok.....but it's not I've included a pic of the way you should never have it set just so you know how not to do it....
