Hello Fellow THLAC members and affiliates,

Thank you all for your support in my first year as your Membership Chairman. This past year we have grown our Club from 185 members at last Fall's Business Meeting to 201 this year. This was accomplished with the efforts of our Marketing Chairman, Brian Powers, and his volunteers who conduct monthly Newbie Workshops and annually support the Austin RV Show. You all played a role with your stories and pictures in The Roadrunner, our bi-monthly newsletter, and with your posts on our Friends of Texas Highland Lakes Facebook page as well as your distribution of our Spotter Cards. These cards are an excellent way to introduce our Club to other Airstreamers. They can be handed out in person or left on a trailer door. The card has links to our website, our Friends of Facebook page as well as my contact information.

Family Style Sugar Cookies

2 cups all purpose flour

3/4 cup sugar

1t. Baking powder

1/4 t. salt

Dash nutmeg

1/2 cup Crisco shortening

1 beaten egg

1/3 cup milk

1/2 t. vanilla



Sift together flour, sugar, baking powder, salt and nutmeg. Using a pastry blender, cut in shortening till like fine crumbs. Combine egg, milk and vanilla. Stir into flour-shortening mix. Blend well. On floured surface roll into 1/8 inch thickness for crisp cookies and 1/4 inch for softer cookies. Cut with cutters. Sprinkle with sugar or leave plain if cookies are to be frosted. Bake on lightly greased cookie sheets at 375 degrees for 7-8 minutes for thin cookies and 11-12 minutes for thicker cookies. Makes 1 1/2—2 dozen cookies.

Frosting: Whip together...

2# powdered sugar

1 1/3 cup Crisco shortening (white not butter flavor)

2 T powdered Dream Whip (dry)

1t. clear vanilla

1 t. almond extract


Can color with food color. Decorate with colored sugar and sprinkles. Allow frosted cookies to set until dry before packaging. Keep leftover frosting covered in the refrigerator.

A Pop Up Rally is a later addition, smaller event with lots of relaxing and fewer activities. Any member may host a pop up rally provided the club president has been notified 30 days prior to the rally and approval has been given. The pop up rally notification is to go to all members either through the newsletter or by email via Constant Contact. Members are to make their own site reservations. There is no rally fee collected as each rig is responsible for its own meals and activities. Attendance at these rallies may be limited due to space constraints.

Rally Hosts Needed

Being a Host is a great (and easy) opportunity to pitch-in and help with our Club. If you never have been a Host, don't sweat it! Volunteer to be a co-host. You will then work with an experienced host. It's fun and there are plenty of experienced hosts and volunteers willing to help! It is a great way to make new friends and get to know your fellow THLAC members.

What exactly does a rally host do? The club president will choose the site for the rally and often will choose a theme. After gathering this information, the host and cohosts plan meals and activities for the rally. Usually this involves a few emails or phone calls. Some rallies have decorations—some do not. Some hosts like to cook meals while others like to have meals catered. The responsibilities for the rally may be divided among the hosts/co-hosts.

What is the difference between the host and co-host? The host takes the lead in getting the rally team together.

Rally hosts and co-hosts may arrive at the rally a day early to begin preparations. Expenses for the additional night are reimbursed by the club. Expenses for the rally incurred by the hosts are reimbursed at the rally and comes from the rally fees collected there.

Rally hosts are responsible for keeping good records of their expenses. Original receipts are to be turned in to the treasurer before the rally fees are collected.

Double the Fun: Back to Back Pop Up Rallies

April 13-16 Inks Lake & April 16-19 Lake Buchanan
