





We are beginning a new year of CAC rallies! 2026 will be loads of fun, with lots of interesting travels across the Carolinas and beyond! But you need to book campsites and register for CAC rallies you want to attend now, as many are filling up. Tanglewood and Shining in Shelby are already wait-list only.

If you have not registered for the May in Mayberry rally, nor booked your campsite at the Mayberry Campground, you need to do that soon, as well. While all the CAC reserved campsites are already booked, the campground still has some other campsites available.

Campfires in Cherokee in June and the Top of Georgia rally in July are both popular and will fill up fairly soon. Other rallies such as Holden Beach and Blue Ridge Waterfalls are just around the corner, so don't delay! It is also not too soon to book your campsite and register for the annual CAC rally in November at Ocean Lakes in Myrtle Beach, SC.

The Shining on the Pamlico Rally in September is still in development but nonetheless, the organizers in Washington, NC, have confirmed that it will be held. Stay tuned for more details and be prepared to register as soon as registration opens. This will be a fun event that you will not want to miss.

If you are interested in the Punkin' Chunkin' Rally in Brasstown, NC, you need to book your campsite at the Murphy KOA before the end of January to get the special CAC discounted rate. Once you have your campsite booked, then remember to register for the rally on the CAC website.

If you want the CAC Christmas at Biltmore experience, I strongly urge you to book your campsite and register on the CAC website for this popular rally very soon. More than half of the available spots are already booked, and this rally will likely be sold out in the next month or so.

One favorite place of CAC member Keith Cooke is Philmont Scout Ranch in NM. He is developing a plan to retrace the northern route of the Santa Fe Trail, making a stopover at Philmont. In 2028, we hope to offer this trip to you as a 23-night expedition where we will meet and spend a few nights in Independence, MO, to begin the Santa Fe Trail. After that, the plan is to gradually make our way to Santa Fe, NM, where along the way we'll travel through Kansas and southeastern Colorado on our way. This expedition is still in its planning stages, but with thoughts of seeing wagon ruts in the Kansas prairielands, dinosaur tracks in Colorado, adobe ruins in New Mexico, and possibly having a western style chuckwagon bison BBQ dinner at the ranch, we almost can't wait to get rolling.

ACI's Balloon Fiesta National Airstream Rally (BFNAR) in Albuquerque, NM, is the first weekend in October and we are trying to coordinate the end of our trip to be within a week of this event. With the drive from Santa Fe to Albuquerque only being about an hour, going to the balloon fiesta at the end of our expedition would be an ideal next stop for you to do on your own. Slots for BFNAR are given out by lottery. Individuals who are interested may submit their entry for the lottery in January of the year they wish to attend.

If you have thoughts or dreams for a CAC expedition, please contact any CAC officer.




Did you notice there were a few upgrades to the ACI Member App recently? You should be running Version 1.0.10. If not, you should update the app on your smart device.
