You do not need to provide food for the entire rally. If our rally site does not have a kitchen, catering or carryout is a great backup option—or precooked food that only needs to be heated. We have a dedicated group of members who are always ready to assist with setup, cleanup, and anything in between.

Finally, please review the [**2026 Rally Schedule**](#) and reserve your campground sites soon. Many of our rally locations are popular destinations and may fill up quickly. Davidson River Recreation Area—site of the *Streamin' with White Squirrels Rally*—is especially popular. **February 8th** is the date you can reserve sites for that rally. I strongly recommend reserving on Feb 8th, as the campground fills quickly. There are also a limited number of sites with electricity and water. Nuts & Bolts



Getting Your Airstream Ready for Camping Season

Camping season is just around the corner—which means it's time to wake up those aluminum beauties from their winter naps and get them road-ready! Whether you're a seasoned full-timer or a weekend wanderer, a little pre-season TLC goes a long way toward smooth travels and stress-free fun.

Here are some easy, satisfying tasks to get your rig sparkling, safe, and adventure-ready:

Shine On

Wash & wax your Airstream to keep that iconic shine glowing and protected

- Check for oxidation or spots and give them a little buff
- Clean windows & mirrors—you'll want crystal clear views of those campfire sunsets

Rigs, Tires & Tow Prep

Inspect your tires for age, cracks, and pressure

- Check your lug nuts—torque as needed
- Examine the hitch & coupler for wear, rust, or loose bolts
- Test your brake controller before you hit the road

Seals & Screens

Treat window and door seals with silicone to prevent sticking or cracking

- Inspect seals for gaps or wear—a quick fix now saves headaches later
- Tighten screen door screws and check that the latch still behaves

Power Up

Charge your batteries fully and check water levels if applicable

- Test all interior & exterior lights (bonus: replace with LEDs if you're upgrading!)
- Check your shore power cord for damage or corrosion
- Check propane levels and inspect pigtails for cracking
- Vacuum vents and clean filters to improve airflow

Odds & Ends That Make a Big Difference

Lubricate stabilizer jacks

- Test smoke, propane & CO detectors
- Restock your tool kit & spare parts box
- Refresh your first-aid kit
- Check your awning for tears, mold, or grumpy hardware

Make It Fun!

Turn your tune-up day into a mini adventure.

Pour a favorite beverage, put on some music, and enjoy the ritual of preparing your home on wheels for the road ahead. Before long, you'll be rolling into a rally, waving to friends, and basking in the glow of your beautifully prepped rig.

Welcome to Camping Season - it's just 32 days away!






