





Tech Tip: Winterization

Airstream Published Step by Step Winterization Procedure(s)

Winter months are here and temperatures have started down. Airstream provides good guidance for how to winterize your Airstream for storage in winter months. Proper winterization involves flushing all the water out of your Airstream's plumbing system and then removing batteries and cleaning out any food that might attract pests.

Why should someone winterize their Airstream?

Unit winterization should protect your investment and avoid unwanted costly repairs. When done correctly, winterizing your Airstream travel trailer removes all the water from the plumbing lines, the holding tanks, the faucets, and water heater. Water that remains in the plumbing system can freeze when the temperature drops below freezing, and can potentially damage pipes, valves, and sensitive mechanical equipment.

The typical process for winterizing begins with draining all plumbing lines and then using an air compressor and adaptor (blow out plug) to blow any remaining water out of the system. An optional, additional method involves pumping non-toxic RV antifreeze through the system. Instructions for both methods are outlined in Airstream's documentation on this website, referenced below.
