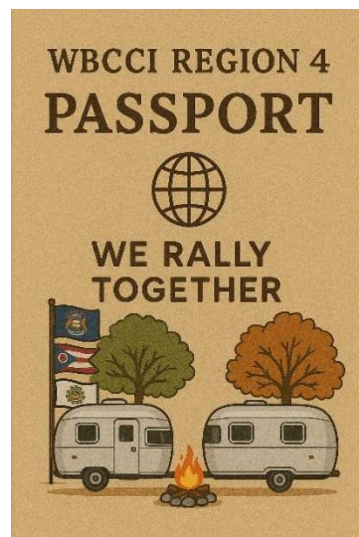

### Steve Lee's Story of "Aligned"

#### **We Have Yet to See Another.**

It was December 2015 and we were shopping for a previously loved Airstream. My wife's family has a property in Northern Michigan where we had a "SOB" trailer we needed to update. My brother-in-law had just purchased a new Flying Cloud 25', and we thought it was very nice. We planned a trip to Woodland Airstream in Grand Rapids as they performed full restorations. I was thinking if we found one needing more work than I wanted to tackle we'd see what they had to offer.

Jennifer and I arrived, asked for a tour and shared our story. We were looking for used as it would likely live under our pavilion Up North. We received a tour of the shop and learned they performed complete restorations. Great, I understood our options on restorations.

The salesman started by showing us new models from Bambi's up to 30' units. I said they are really nice but we were looking for used. We then went outside and looked at a consignment trailer looking a bit weatherworn. Jennifer went inside followed by the salesman and by the time I stepped inside I could see, by the look on her face, this unit was to be ours.

Perfect for our needs. A corner bed, shower, bath, galley and gaucho up front that made for a spacious layout. Not being Airstream savvy, the model names meant nothing to me. This was a 1997, Excella, Classic, 21'9" long, dual axle, widebody. We made the deal and took delivery in the next weeks.

While at Woodland then owner, Chad Carlison, told us this was a unique trailer and we would likely not see many like it. He also suggested we attend “Urban Air” in Eaton Rapids, MI.

We took Chad’s advice and signed up for Urban Air, our first Airstream event. While there, a number of astute Airstream owners stopped in their tracks asking us about our trailer. “You have a 21’ Airstream with dual axles???” “Wait a minute, this 21’ is a wide body???” “This is a Classic with solid oak cabinets???”. Well after a while I took the hint, perhaps this Airstream is a bit more special than just something that caught our eye.

We used the Airstream Up North a bit but decided it was too nice to leave at the river property. We contacted Woodland and scheduled a full exterior restoration - polish, seal, paint, the works. The interior was 100% original, in like new condition and needed nothing.

With things all shined up we loved the trailer even more. I couldn’t help but wonder about all the questions we received. This led me to contact Joe Peplinski the ACI historian about our trailer. Joe replied, “Airstream made the 21’ corner bed, corner bath from 1992 thru 1997. It was called a Sovereign from 1992-1996 and became the “Excella” for one year in 1997. The model was narrower from 1992-1995 and became a “wide body” in 1996 (the same time the longer trailers became “wide bodies”). In general, the 21’ tandems were made in small numbers so they are quite rare. Production numbers have not been available.”

Well, that’s cool. We have a low production trailer, only one year of the Excella name. So, we started keeping an eye out for another. We attended Alumapoloosa 11 and thought we found one, nope it was an older narrow body version. We attended a Region 4 rally in Wooster Ohio and saw another. Nope that was a one off 23’ built for a caravan leader. We attended international in Sedalia, MO and I rode my bike up every lane, no 21’ Excella Classic.

I reached out to a dealer known for towing accessories looking for a brake controller for our Interstate. He asked what I was considering pulling. I said a car hauler and possibly a vintage Airstream and sent a picture. He immediately answered back, “I know that trailer, It’s a prototype.” I thought great but I already have the historian’s take on it and he didn’t mention prototype; he just couldn’t find any production numbers.

A week later the dealer e-mailed me back. “I checked with a friend that worked at Airstream and he agreed that trailer is a prototype.” Months later I was able to talk to this dealer in person at the Sedalia rally. I asked him why he thought this trailer was a prototype. He said Airstream brought this trailer to the 1997 dealer show. All the dealers said, “**Don’t build it!**” At 21’ a dual axle, wide body, Classic will cost too much. At that price customers will go for a longer trailer.

This rally takes place on private property in the heart of **Cuyahoga Valley National Park**. Since there is no RV camping within the park itself, this rally offers a rare opportunity to explore over 125 miles of hiking trails, 87 miles of Towpath Trail for biking and hiking (dogs allowed on most), more than 100 waterfalls, scenic ledges, a beaver marsh, and abundant

wildlife viewing opportunities. The Cuyahoga River Water Trail also provides paddling opportunities for canoes and kayaks.

The **Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad** runs through the valley, and we hope to reserve a California Zephyr dome car that accommodates up to 60 passengers. If this is not available, attendees may schedule rides independently. Additional details will be shared as plans are finalized.

Camping will be available on a **boondock basis**, with limited access to water and electric, a dump port onsite, and a large communal bonfire pit.

### **Important Deadline:**

Reservation deadline for the Scenic Railroad excursion is **May 28, 2026**.

### **Rally & Other Fees:**

In lieu of a rally fee, a **50/50 raffle** will be held to cover expenses. Attendees are asked to bring a six-pack of beer or a bottle of spirits to share at community events.
