Join Our Grapes and Grains Intraclub Caravan

The Inaugural Sipping Across California National Caravan was quite successful, so we have decided to grab just 3 of the stops and create this more compact caravan, exploring the fabulous products of Grapes and Grains while enjoying plenty of opportunities to take in the majesty of the Pacific Ocean coast. Our adventure will begin in Paso Robles, CA with a motorcoach trip to San Simeon to visit the renowned Hearst Castle followed by a stop in Cambria, a Seaside Village bustling with shops, history and restaurants. The motorcoach journey will include a final stop for adult beverages in a special setting as we get to know each other. Next stop, Half Moon Bay! We will be camping with spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean, enjoy some amazing seafood, and enjoy the Annual Jazz and Wine Festival downtown. The final stop will be in California's 2nd most visited destination, the Napa Valley! (Disneyland is #1). Our drive day will include crossing the San Francisco Bay and taking in the San Francisco Skyline. Our stay here will include tasting fabulous wines and cheeses, visiting the historic Sonoma Square, and a closing luncheon with the Winemaker and Chef on our private patio at an *exclusive estate vineyard*.

- Restrooms and Showers: Clean (yet rustic!) restrooms and showers are available for campers.
- Hiking and Biking Trails: Over 25 miles of trails for hiking and biking, including trails leading to Lake Marie. Please note that trails close at sunset. **Dogs are not allowed on trails.*
- Dog Park: A fenced dog park is available for off-leash fun.
- Disc Golf: Available adjacent to the campground.

Any member/registrant who cancels within 30 days of the Caravan start date will forfeit any prepaid Caravan fees and depending on the venue, potential RV site fees. Regardless of the reason or cause, if the timeliness of cancellation of your attendance does not allow G&G or its Host(s) to find replacement attendees or obtain refunds from any of the vendors or providers, a refund will not be made, and forfeiture of those costs will be incurred by the cancelling member.

If Grapes & Grains should cancel a Caravan or event, all fees paid by any member/registrant will be refunded.

This Grapes & Grains refund policy is premised on the concept that the Intra-Club should neither profit from nor subsidize the cost of any member or registrant who cancels after registering for a G&G sponsored or hosted Caravan or event. We understand that circumstances arise where a cancellation may be necessary, and every effort will be made to minimize the financial impact on both the Intra-Club and the member/registrant.
