Steps:



Chicken Salad Rolls

Ingredients:

6 cups chopped fried chicken

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup mayonnaise

3 Tbsp. sweet pickle juice

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup roughly chopped sweet pickle chips

(Mt. Olive Sweet Heat Bread & Butter)

4 cups Iceberg lettuce

2-3 stalks celery, diced (about $\frac{3}{4}$ cup)

2-3 onions, (dark and green parts, chopped finely)

$\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. black pepper

2 packages (8-count) top split rolls or any type of bread/roll,
your choice

Chives, snipped as a garnish (optional)

Instructions:

1. Chop up chicken into small pieces.
2. In a separate bowl, combine remaining ingredients except the rolls.
3. Fold chicken into mixture.
4. Refrigerate for 30 minutes.

When you are ready to serve or pack your picnic, stuff salad into rolls and keep safely cooled.
