We now have online rally registration available.

We will now be registering online (and paying where necessary), via our club web pages on the Airstream Club.org website. It is very easy to use.

### Steps:

### Packing your Bearings

Every year we all have out maintenance that we have to do to maintain our Airstream's longevity and for our safety.

For those of us with older Airstreams, we have maintenance that our newer counterparts are fortunate to get to avoid, and that includes packing wheel bearings. Your manual can tell you if you have never-lube bearings. If so, you need to inspect your bearings every season, but you get out of the packing stage. For the rest of us, we need to repack every 10,000 miles or every season per Airstream manual. Packing wheel bearings is not a glamorous job and it's messy, but avoiding it could cause serious damage or problems if not performed correctly.

Over time, the grease deteriorates, and if left unattended with inadequate grease, the bearings will eventually overheat and possibly cause expensive damage to the hub and/or spindle. In extreme cases, the hub/wheel could lock or even separate from the axle. That's no fun when you're cruising down the highway. So, if you haven't repacked or replaced your wheel bearings you need to plan to get dirty on the weekend.

*Time for each wheel about 30 minutes.*

#### *Materials needed:*

- Shop Rags
- Dexter Wheel Bearing Grease Tube
- Grease Gun
- Heavy Duty Disposable Gloves (Optional but recommended)
- Universal Bearing Packer
- Grease Seal Puller
- Soft Blow Hammer
- Lifting Jack
- Adjustable Wrench
- Large, slotted screwdriver
- Grease cleaning solvent



1. Lift your Airstream using proper equipment to secure your Airstream from falling. Reminder: never lift your Airstream using the axle! There are lifting points on the bottom belly pan usually with a label showing you where to lift.
2. Remove the tire. This is a great opportunity to inspect your brakes for wear and tear.
3. Next is to remove the dust cap from the hub using a flat-slot screwdriver.
4. Behind the dust cap is the castle nut, which holds the bearing in place. A cotter pin is attached to the nut and its end pins must be straightened and the pin pulled through the nut before the nut can be removed. Next, the castle nut is simply loosened and removed.

Rock the hub back and forth and the outer wheel bearing should push forward. Simply pull it off the spindle, but don't immediately wipe away the grease. Inspect the grease on the spindle for signs of metal that indicate bearing damage. If no signs of damage are visible:

1. Clean the grease off spindle bearing with solvent and check bearing for pits, scoring, or metal that has a bluish color on the rollers indicating the rollers were overheated. If none are present, the bearing can be reused—but wheel bearings are cheap, so it's not a bad idea to install new ones.
2. On the back side of the hub there is a grease seal that needs to be replaced. Using a grease seal tool, gently pry the seal out of the back-plate exposing the inner bearings.
3. Next, the bearing needs to be packed. Using the Universal Bearing Packer tool and a grease gun, push Dexter wheel bearing grease through the bearing until grease appears through every gap of the bearing. If you are reusing bearing, push grease through until the grease is clean.
4. Install the inner bearing into the hub and using a grease seal tool lightly tap the seal until it's firmly seated.
5. Slide the hub back on the spindle and slide the outer bearing into the hub until it's firmly seated.
6. Screw the castle nut and washers on until it's finger tight, being sure the hub is firmly pressed against the spindle.
7. It is recommended to use a new cotter pin and bend the pins in opposite directions.
8. Pack the inside of the dust cap with wheel bearing grease before reinstalling it on the hub. Use a dead-blow hammer or a similar tool to prevent damaging the cap.
9. Reinstall the wheel and give it a spin rocking the tire back and forth to feel for movement. If you feel movement the castle nut needs to be tightened more.
10. Lastly, plan for the next rally and see your friends.

These instructions lack in-depth details, but there are great YouTube videos that can help give you clarity. Only use Dexter Wheel Bearing grease! Never mix grease types as it can have a chemical effect that may lead to bearing failure.

# A Little Something About Us by Danielle Ward (BRN 05974)




Hello &
