That point was reinforced during my drive home from Florida after Christmas, when my trailer suffered a rare double tire blowout. Fortunately, the training I've received over the years from our maintenance professional, DJ Mastin, owner of Broken Rivets, paid off. I was able to identify both failures before any damage occurred—even though my new rig was missing a critical cable that rendered my Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) useless.

Much credit goes to a Good Samaritan who pulled up alongside me and pointed out a smoking tire. The second failure followed shortly after getting back on the road from the first blow out, when I felt a shudder and heard a loud bang, prompting me to pull over again (see pics). All I could think about was how right DJ has always been about the importance of a TPMS. It's nearly impossible to know a tire is

failing—or has already failed—without one. A properly functioning modern system also monitors tire temperature, which is critical for early warning of belt failures. It also reinforces why tires should be changed based on age and use, not just tread wear.

If you take away one thing from this story, let it be this: please make plans now to attend the April Maintenance Rally. It was a great way for new members to meet other NORVA members and learn about not only NORVA, but the bigger ACI organization. With a beautiful Powerpoint presentation the two of them tag-teamed informing and explaining all the features and benefits of belonging not

only to NORVA but automatically belonging to the different tiers of the Airstream Club International (ACI), also known as the Wally Bayam Caravan Club International (WBCCI), among a couple of other names. Doug explained the club, breaking down information on the international club, regional clubs and local clubs. Other officers stepped up to share information about our club's rallies and caravans. It was a good time for new and old members alike.



Preview: 2026 ACI International Rally

John Bevis, our 2nd VP has planned a terrific caravan which will run from August 7-20, arriving early at the International Rally in Minot, ND, which will take place from August 22nd to the 27th.

For those who have previously traveled with NORVA caravans, this one may be a bit aggressive, as a couple of the day drives may push up close to 300 miles, most in 200-250 range. The caravan will convene 40 miles north of Pittsburgh at the Airstream only park, where we will have an organizational meeting before heading out. Some stops are 2 days, one 3, and others one day only, with total distance about

1800 miles. The route takes the caravan across Northern Ohio, then Michigan, north to the “Upper Peninsula.” We plan 3 nights at a campground north of the Mackinac Bridge, with good access to several points of interest. From there we head westward through upper Minnesota lake country, before arriving at Minot. The northern portion follows U.S. Route 2 (not an Interstate). Along the way are various attractions and points of interest, which will be included. We will also plan some group activities and dinners.

Some of proposed stopping points and attractions.

Penn Wood Airstream Only Park. Two nights

Maumee Bay State Park, near Toledo. Two nights

National Museum of the Great Lakes Museum and lake ships for tours.

Lakeshore RV Park, St. Ignace, MI. Three nights

Multiple attractions including Mackinaw Island, Soo Locks, others

Duluth, MN. Two nights.

Multiple attractions including Great Lakes Aquarium, Castle Rock Lighthouse

Grand Forks, MN. Two nights.

Upper Minnesota Lake Country

While it’s hard to know exact costs, my estimate is in neighborhood of \$1700-2000, covering campground costs and some attractions, dinners, etc. Upon signing up, we need a deposit of \$500, with balance due later (60 days) once final costs are determined. We have several already, and can add a few more, up to 10 max. Reach out to me if you are interested and I’ll give more details.

We got Seneca when he was 8 weeks old. His first camping trip was to Camp Hatteras in the Outer Banks. Doug said, "What if he doesn't like the water?" Well, before we put his little body into the water, his paws were going...he loved it! He loved swimming, retrieving toys from the ocean, rivers, lakes...it didn't matter as long as he was in the water.

He soon learned that camping was fun! All we had to do was hook the trailer up and he was behind us step by step...ready to go. No wonder he loved camping, he met the nicest people, especially in the NORVA Airstream Club. Seneca would proudly carry his disc everywhere, but he wouldn't give it to you. If you were able to pry it from his mouth, then he loved for you to throw it and he would retrieve it.

In his almost 11 years, we did not go on a camping trip without him. He traveled to Maine to the International Rally, he traveled on the Cowboy Caravan to Wyoming, and then toured all the states back home.
