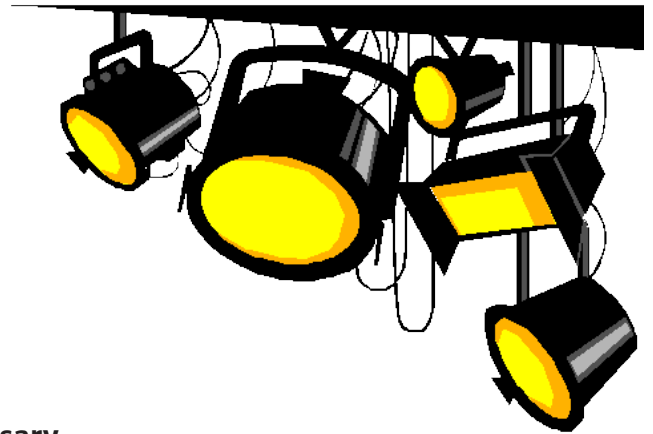

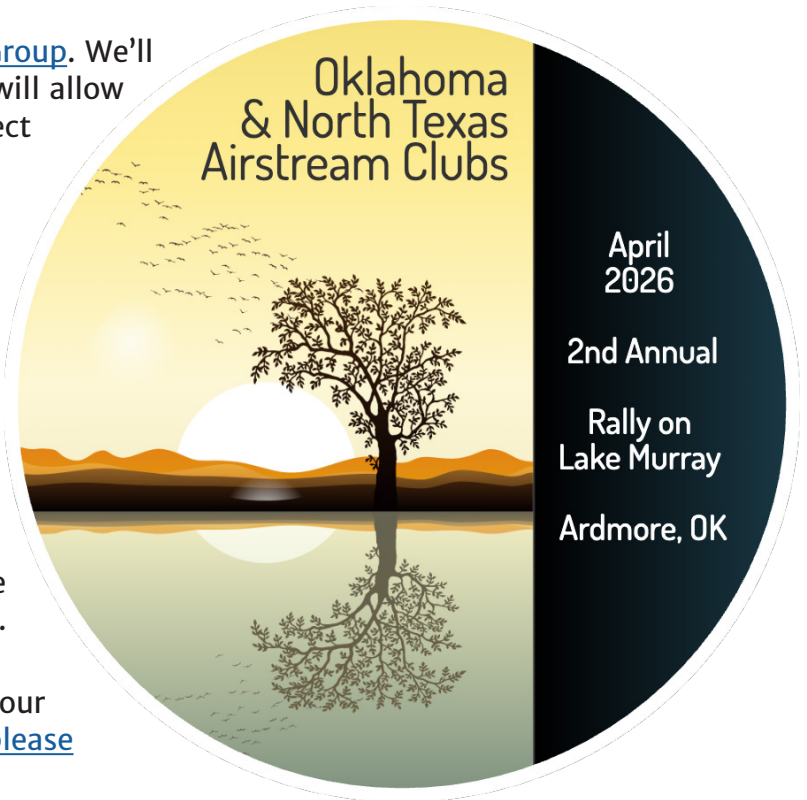

Co-Editor David's Travelogue

February 2026: Frank Lloyd Wright

This month we'll be visiting Frank Lloyd Wright attractions from coast to coast. This theme-within-a-larger-trip emerged when we were visiting my cousin in Scottsdale last April. We finally decided to take in Wright's southwestern desert studio, Taliesin West. After all, this was our third time in the area and it was only 15 minutes from Westworld of Scottsdale where we were parked for a week.

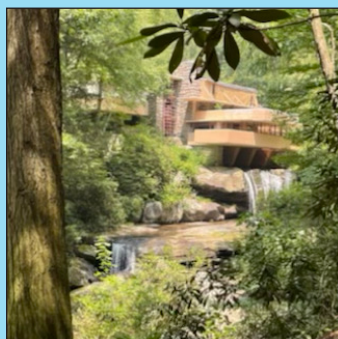


Taliesin West—an oasis of architectural creativity in the desert

[Taliesin West](#), according to its website, is, “Frank Lloyd Wright’s desert laboratory in Arizona.” Established in 1937 on several hundred acres of land in the foothills of the McDowell Mountains, it was built and maintained almost entirely by Wright and his students. This sets it apart from most other Wright sites, which were built for clients. Today, it’s managed by the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation.

[Ennis House](#) is a curiosity, not a destination, because it’s privately owned and not open for tours. Nevertheless, we thought it was worth a drive-by, something we never would have gotten away with had our friends not loaned us their car (pequeñas streets no bueno for grande truck). We know the exterior from the Vincent Price movie, *House on Haunted Hill*, which we watch every Halloween. However, being located in the Hollywood Hills, it’s been featured elsewhere in movies and television. In the end, we couldn’t see much at all because of the house’s elevation, vegetation, and retaining wall. Worth the trip nonetheless.

[Fallingwater](#) might be the most famous of Wright’s buildings—for good reason! Unless you’ve been living under the rock that this house is built on, you know what I’m talking about ... so I won’t talk about it. I’ll just share a couple photos.

[Kentuck Knob](#) is a house you should visit if you go to Fallingwater—it's just down the road a piece. If you stay at Ohiopyle State Park, as we did, it's even closer, only 10 minutes away. It's instantly recognizable as a Wright creation, though in a more modest presentation known as his Usonian style. Single-story Usonian homes aimed to be more affordable and efficient for a middle-class lifestyle. You be the judge.



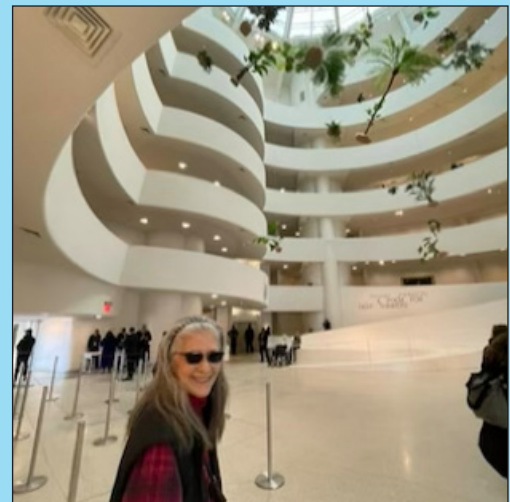
Kentuck Knob—a middle-class house in Wright's Usonian style

Wright may have been an architect of great stature, but his designs are not made for us tall folks!



[The Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum](#)—or just The Guggenheim to most—is Wright's spiraling concrete masterpiece among an ocean of skyscrapers. This is another one that needs no introduction. Even if you're not a fan of modern art, it's worth the price of admission.

And speaking of admission, I'll leave you with a tip. If you ever incorporate a Wright theme into one of your trips, be sure to check out the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation's [reciprocal sites program](#). If you purchase a foundation membership at the "Insider" level or above, you'll be entitled to free admission into any number of Wright sites throughout the country. The more sites you visit, the more you'll save. You're welcome.
