Registration

Rally registration will take place online via the Oregon Airstream Club website starting in January. Members will be emailed in advance with date and time details on when 2026 rally general registrations will open.

A 3-day registration process will be used.

- Day-1: hosts/co-hosts will register for their own rallies
- Day-2: hosts/co-hosts will register for a “thank you” rally
- Day-3: general registration

Complete registration schedules and instructions will be sent by email several days in advance.

- Rallies will be displayed in date order
- Click on any rally to view event web page
- When registration is open, a “Register Online Here” button will appear
- Complete the online registration form including type of payment. You’ll have the option to pay by credit card, PayPal, Apple Pay, or by check.

If you pay for your registrations by check, please mail it directly to the OAC treasurers, Robert Kraft and Sandra Johnson (email randsoac@gmail.com for their address). After you register online, you will be able to pay for multiple rallies with one check. Please enclose a note with your check detailing your rally registration(s).

We will have a few rallies that will be confirmed and booked after the printed version of the rally handbook is distributed. These rallies will be added to the online version of the Rally Handbook and to the website for registration. The same three-day rally registration process will be used. Members will be emailed in advance with date and time details on when these additional rally registrations will open.

Some rallies are very popular and fill quickly so don’t delay. If the rally you want is full, immediately contact the host and ask to be placed on their Waitlist. Very often people on the waitlist secure spots as cancellations occur, so don’t be discouraged. We have provided the phone number and email address of each rally host. Also, feel free to reach out to them with questions or concerns regarding their rally.

Cancellation Policy

We get it, life happens, and things come up. For simplicity, here is the OAC rally cancellation policy.

If you need to cancel your rally reservation, please notify your rally host immediately.

Your rally host will coordinate with the OAC rally coordinator, responsible rally manager, and treasurer to assist you in properly processing and recording the date of your cancellation.

You cannot give your rally spot to someone else on your own, as there are members on the waitlist with priority for registering for that rally and the rally host will coordinate.

If you must cancel your registration for a rally, please do so as early as possible. This will allow the rally host to work with members on their waitlist to fill your spot. If, for any reason, your cancellation causes the OAC to incur any cost (full or partial), you will be responsible for paying that cost.

In general, all cancellations will be processed monthly on a batch basis. If you cancel within 30 days of a Rally, your cancellation, and any associated refund, will be processed after the rally has occurred and all external site and shared facility costs have been fully accounted.

If you cancel your registration for a group camp (GC) rally, you will not receive a refund unless someone takes your spot from the host's waitlist AND the rally is sold out. This is to prevent the OAC from incurring costs due to cancellations and to limit OAC costs should the rally not sell out. These group camp type rallies are clearly noted in the rally handbook and on the registration page with a "GC" included in the rally name.

All cancellations are subject to all rally venue cancellation policies, including any associated administrative fees, and a \$5 OAC cancellation fee. The total of these costs will not exceed your initial payment amount. Our treasurer will be in contact with you regarding any refund.

Meals and Food

To manage rally costs and to simplify associated tax documentation, the OAC has a policy of not including any meal costs in the rally pricing.

Any group meals planned by a rally host, which would require any significant expense to the rally host, are to be offered by the host to their campers on an individual meal, per person "opt-in/opt-out" basis.

The rally host must define the per-person, per-meal cost at the time of offering any such meals to their campers.

Each camper "opting-in" will be expected to personally reimburse the rally host for costs incurred on their behalf.
