Message from John Deegan ~ Reg 5, President *A New Year and a Call to Get Involved*

Don't Miss the Big One ~ Region 5 Rolls Into Madison's Riverfront for a Special Event Rally

Now that thoughts are turning to travel plans, the Martins and I wanted to share more exciting news and details about the Region 5 Special Event - Madison Rollin' on the River Rally. If you have not had the opportunity to visit Historic Madison, Indiana – you don't want to miss this!

Unlike our traditional rallies held in campgrounds or state parks, an urban rally puts you right in the heart of a vibrant town. Instead of being tucked away in nature, you'll be parked along the scenic Ohio River on Vaughn Drive, steps away from Madison's historic downtown. This means:

- * Close Access: Shops, restaurants, wineries, and attractions are all within close proximity.
- * Immersive Experience: You will be part of the town's rhythm, enjoying local culture, architecture, and events as a resident rather than a visitor.
- * Unique Parking: Each Airstream becomes part of the streetscape, offering river views on one side and historic landmarks on the other.
- * Community Connection: We are busy working on special arrangements with local businesses and attractions, creating a one-of-a-kind experience you won't find in a campground.



The rally will begin on Tuesday, June 9th at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds where we will stay overnight with 30 amp electric and water hookups. Wednesday morning, everyone will fill their freshwater tanks and use the dump station at the Fairgrounds to empty their black and gray water tanks. Groups of 4 – 5 trailers will be escorted down the hill into Historic Madison where they will be parked on Vaughn Drive along the riverfront and tow vehicles unhooked. Tow vehicles will be parked either in a close lot or on the opposite side of Vaughn. We will have 30 amp electric available along Vaughn, with additional details to follow.

Registration includes a pass to Crystal Beach Aquatic Center - a Madison landmark since 1939, when its pool and bathhouse opened as a WPA project. That makes it 87 years old in 2026—a true piece of history you'll enjoy during your stay! The upper level of the Center houses Hunter Hall – a reception hall with elevator and decks to take in the views which will be our gathering place during the rally. The Aquatic area boasts slides, a zero-depth (beach-style) entry, which means the pool entrance gradually slopes from the deck into the water, lazy river and an abundance of grassy areas for picnicking or napping. The pass also includes access to showers and restrooms during your stay. Just a couple of blocks down is a newly renovated playground and ballfields. Other adventures include duck pin bowling, browsing the Lumber Mill Antique Mall or Farmer's Market, touring Madison from a boat, trolley, train or biplane.



For outdoor enthusiasts, Clifty Falls State Park is nearby with over 10 trails showcasing dramatic waterfalls, canyons, and scenic overlooks. Notable hikes include Clifty Falls, Tunnel Falls, Little Clifty Falls, and Hoffman Falls. Or enjoy Heritage Trail & Hatcher Hill (which begins at the end of Vaughn Drive) with paved pathways ideal for hiking, biking, walking, and dog-walking, with hilltop overlooks. Speaking of dogs – a complimentary fenced in dog park is located along Vaughn just in front of Lanthier Winery & Gardens.

Exploring Madison is even more fun and convenient with a golf cart. Rentals are available for the entire rally duration at a discounted rate—but quantities are limited! Call Acree Alley Golf Carts at 812-701-2335 and mention the Airstream Rally to reserve yours now to guarantee that you have easy access to all the shops, restaurants, and attractions without the hassle of moving your tow vehicle.

Saturday evening a banquet dinner will be held and upon departure on Sunday the use of the dump station at the Riverview Campground (located at the end of Vaughn) is included.

This rally combines the comforts of your Airstream with the excitement of a close historic downtown, making it perfect for those who love exploring local culture for an unforgettable riverside adventure. Find out more about Madison here: VisitMadison.org
