All the people who usually have articles in the newsletter got a reprieve for this. We're only focusing on events this month.


The second quarter edition of the newsletter will still be sent out in April. Feel free to send me any articles or events for that.







Amy & Rick Lieblein and Karen Fisher & Wally Kimmel are excited as we are finalizing the plans for a new caravan that we will be leading in the fall of 2026 for the first time.

Here's the info we have to date (note this is subject to change plus or minus as we finalize the details).

Fall in Love with Michigan Airstream Caravan

Sep 18–Oct 24, 2026

36 nights

10 stops

Explore the lower peninsula of Michigan while enjoying the fall colors. Check it out!

We'll start the caravan by meeting at the Harbortown RV Resort in Monroe on Sep 18. After the Opening Banquet and getting acquainted, we'll spend three full days exploring the city of Detroit – a trip to Eastern Market, the Detroit Institute of Art, First Congregational Underground Railroad Living Museum, and the newly restored Michigan Central Train Station are just some of the options. Visits to Belle Isle and Hart Plaza will also be included.

Our second stop is Kalamazoo where you'll get a chance to explore the Gilmore Car Museum, visit the Air Zoo Museum, a Bird Sanctuary, and other local places of interest.

From Grand Haven (near Grand Rapids), we'll explore the Meijer Sculpture Garden and visit the Grand Rapids Riverfront. Free time in Grand Haven will allow you to visit the Gerald Ford Presidential Museum, take a day trip to Holland and/or Saugatuck or take a bike ride on Lakeside Trail.

In Traverse City, we'll visit Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore, tour the Traverse City State Hospital, take a winery tour on the Leelanau Peninsula, visit Fishtown and even have the option of taking fly fishing lessons.

On the way to Mackinaw City, you'll have time to stop and explore the town of Petosky and drive through "The Tunnel of Trees". While we're in Mackinaw City, we'll take the ferry to Mackinaw Island where you'll have time to explore and/or bike around the island. No visit to the island is complete without having lunch at the Grand Hotel.

Our next stop will be in Alpena where we'll visit the Great Lakes Maritime Heritage Center and Dinosaur Gardens. We hope to be able to include a Shipwreck Tour in a glass bottom boat.

Then on to Grayling where you'll be able to visit Hartwick Pines, take an optional canoe trip on the Au Sable River or do some fishing.

In Bay City, a presentation at the Delta College Planetarium with free time to visit historic downtown Bay City, ride bikes on the River Walk, or visit the Saginaw Valley Naval Museum, home of the USS Edson DD-946. This Vietnam era Forest Sherman Class destroyer is one of two left in the US. Another day you'll visit Dow Gardens, do a canopy walk among the tree tops, see the Tridge (a 3 legged Bridge) and visit the Aldon Dow House.

A quick visit to Frankenmuth will give you time to explore their quaint downtown, have a world famous chicken dinner at either the Bavarian Inn or Zehnder's, and visit Bronner's Christmas Wonderland, World's Largest Christmas Store.

Our last stop in Ypsilanti will include trips to The Henry Ford Museum, Greenfield Village, and a Ford factory tour to see how they build all those Ford pick-ups. We'll have our Closing Banquet on Oct 23 and wish you all safe travels when you leave the caravan on Oct 24.

Of course, there will be plenty of meals included, social times, GAMs, and other activities.

This first year we are only taking 10 rigs plus the leaders so space is limited. If you can't make it this year, please consider adding us to your plans for 2027. Dates will be similar and we plan to increase the caravan size to 20 rigs plus the leaders.

This rally takes place on private property in the heart of **Cuyahoga Valley National Park**. Since there is no RV camping within the park itself, this rally offers a rare opportunity to explore over 125 miles of hiking trails, 87 miles of Towpath Trail for biking and hiking (dogs allowed on most), more than 100 waterfalls, scenic ledges, a beaver marsh, and abundant wildlife viewing opportunities. The Cuyahoga River Water Trail also provides paddling opportunities for canoes and kayaks.

The Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad runs through the valley, and we hope to reserve a California Zephyr dome car that accommodates up to 60 passengers. If this is not available, attendees may schedule rides independently. Additional details will be shared as plans are finalized.

Camping will be available on a **boondock basis**, with limited access to water and electric, a dump port onsite, and a large communal bonfire pit.

Important Deadline:

Reservation deadline for the Scenic Railroad excursion is **May 28, 2026**.

Rally & Other Fees:

In lieu of a rally fee, a 50/50 raffle will be held to cover expenses. Attendees are asked to bring a six-pack of beer or a bottle of spirits to share at community events. Donations will also be accepted to help support Buster Brandish, who works with inner-city youth on birdwatching programs. The estimated cost for the private Scenic Railroad railcar is \$60–\$65 per person, including onboard appetizers (cost dependent on number of reservations). Optional sightseeing attractions in the area may have additional fees.


