

# Security Concerns with Your Airstream

There are a couple of specific areas Airstreamers seem to be concerned about - they are:

- How can I secure my trailer so no one takes off with it?
- Is there any way to secure my gas bottles so they are not stolen?
- I have AGM batteries that are very expensive...how can I secure them?

There is more than one good answer to providing security for your Airstream while traveling. I have listed a few below that hopefully will get you headed in the right direction.



## Locks for Atwood Coupler

When you are looking for a coupler lock, you will need to make sure the lock will fit over the lip around the Atwood coupler.

*The Atwood coupler Airstream uses has a higher rolled lip around coupler base.*

**Various choices** - There are locks for the coupler latch as well as the ones that fit into the ball socket. Some of the manufacturers of these types of locks are: Reese, Master Lock and Proven Industries.



### **Gas Bottle Locks**

Another area of concern are the gas bottles, whether they are aluminum or steel, it can be a costly proposition if they are stolen. So, what are some choices for protecting your gas bottles?

**Reese 3/16" Coupler Lock - about \$6**



Just line up your gas bottle hold down with the bar on bottle cover and drill a 1/4" hole and install coupler lock.
