Battery Disconnect light Question

On the Battery Disconnect panel next to the exterior door, the red light is on. I just noticed this. We are camping and using the batteries, which are being recharged by a solar panel. We just noticed for the fi rst time that the red light is on. The switch is on "USE." We have not switched it to STORE.

SHOULD THE RED LIGHT BE ON? Thanks

If you are plugged into shore power the light will be on whether you are in the disconnected or use position. Hitting the in use button while plugged in will allow you to charge your house batteries.

If you are unplugged and you hit the battery disconnect your light will go out. However, you will also be disconnecting the house batteries and your trailers 12 volt system. All switched 12 volt power will be disconnected; some items such as radio memory and LP detector will still be energized.
