
Changing Halogen Lamps

Airstream is using recessed halogen lights in several of its product lines; CCD'S, Safari SE'S, the Interstate van as well as the A Series motorhomes. With their use comes the question of how do you change the bulb, here are some tips.





Remove lens using a small screwdriver. Place the screwdriver between the lens trim ring and light housing. Gently pry outward being careful not to mar or scratch the finish of the light, the light lens will snap out of socket. Be careful not to drop lens. You now have access to change the halogen light bulb.

When changing the Halogen light bulb it is important to use a handkerchief or Kleenex to protect the halogen bulb from the natural oil present on human hands. This oil will shorten the life of the new bulb.

Caution: Don't get a smashed finger





The halogen light is secured in the ceiling using two retaining springs. One spring located on each side of the light. These springs closely resemble a mousetrap. They are lifted upwards to clear the aluminum inside skin. Once the light is inside the ceiling the tension of the spring holds the light firmly into place.

To remove the complete light assembly, carefully pull downward on the light assembly. Be very careful
