## **Disc Brake Safety Note**

I just thought I would pass along to you some info on brake hoses. I have a 2006 31' Classic with disc brakes. Coming through Austin, Texas, the other day, I had to get on the brakes pretty hard to avoid a car pulling in front of me and found I had no trailer brakes.

Upon inspection, I found that the rubber brake hoses could rub against the frame, which rubbed a hole in the hose when the axle moved up and down. I suggest everyone with disc brakes do a check and inspect their hoses. My street side hoses were OK, but both curb side hoses were worn through.

My Airstream dealer did a good job of quickly getting the hoses to me, but in the meantime NAPA Auto can match.
