Curtains

A question that I get asked quite often is how do I clean my curtains? Airstream currently uses two types of curtains in travel trailers; a loose weave type and a polyester type for all travel trailers. The material for current Classic trailers is manufactured by Milliken Inc. and has been used since 2002. The curtain material 100% polyester. Safari, International and Bambi trailers currently uses curtain material manufactured by Dana Mills. It is 87% Polyester and 13% cotton and has been used since Safari's introduction in 1998.

Airstream recommends dry cleaning for both types of curtains; however Classic trailer curtains can be washed using the gentle wash cycle. We recommend using Woolite® to wash and then let hang to air dry, if you use bleach it has to be **non**-chlorine. Safari, International and Bambi trailer curtains are dry clean only.

How do I remove the curtain?

To remove the curtain first unsnap them from the wall, then remove the screw or pop rivet from the end of the top and bottom track, then slide the tabs out of the track.
