The following is some information and tips that I hope you can use with your Airstream.

Plywood Flooring—Travel Trailers

Airstream Customer Service receives frequent inquiries as to the type of flooring used on our trailer chassis. Airstream currently uses plywood flooring for all trailer floors.

The flooring is Sturd-I-Floor (APA), Exposure 1, with WPB (water and boil proof) type bonding adhesive.

Airstream uses **Exposure 1 Grade Plywood**; Exposure 1 rated plywood uses the same bonding adhesive as exterior plywood and is designed to be used in humid conditions and will tolerate getting wet for prolonged periods of time.



The flooring is 19/32" (5/8"), tongue and groove Exposure 1 Grade Plywood.

Additional Moisture Protection

Airstream also applies additional moisture protection around the perimeter and edges of the flooring using a 12" band of anti-wicking material. It is manufactured by Dolphin adhesives.
