- Presidential Use: President John F. Kennedy used an Airstream as a mobile office at White Sands Missile Range in 1963.
- The Funeral Coach: In the early 1980s, Airstream briefly manufactured a "Funeral Coach" that could transport a casket, 14 family members, and up to 20 flower baskets.

Membership Renewal Season is here!

For many of our members, the 2026 Membership Renewal season begins October 3rd. Below are a few highlights to remember:

- Membership dues are \$99 per year.
- The primary or partner member MUST be logged in to the member-only portal to renew online.
- Members with multiple Big Red Numbers (BRN) can renew their additional BRN in the member-only portal at the time of renewal.
- HQ is collecting Affiliate and Intra-Club dues.
- All Lifetime members must go through the renewal process.
- HQ will be notifying members it is time to renew by postcard, email and social media starting November 1st.
- HQ will notify Local Clubs if there is an issue contacting a member.
- The deadline for the 2026 Published Membership Directory is January 31, 2026.
- Members can pay by credit card or ACH (bank transfer).
 - * Credit card payments will be charged a 3% convenience fee but are processed immediately.
 - * ACH payments may take 3–5 business days to process.
