Andy & I enjoy stopping at State Parks across the country. One of our favorite and more frequent venues is First Landing State Park in Virginia Beach, VA. Located right on the Chesapeake Bay, many of the campsites provide super-easy access to the beach (well maintained, but not attended). Most of the sites are nestled in the maritime forest, there are plenty that accommodate larger rigs, and have 50-amp/water hookups. There is a convenient dumpstation available for campers. The location is a pleasant ride down the DelMarVa Peninsula and great for those of us who must avoid the Baltimore Harbor tunnels and want to skip the DC traffic. And once hooked-up there are plenty of great fresh seafood markets and restaurants, and nearby things-to-do (we really enjoyed the Norfolk Navy Base tour). The campground is large but does fill-up (particularly on weekends) so book early in the 11-month window.

She and George (married 74 years!) were model Keystone clubbers for many years before retiring their traveling shoes in 2017. While George tackled every role for the club (except the presidency), Peg was the Kourier editor from 1992 – 1996. As Jody noted 'Peg was the Kourier editor when cut-and-paste literally meant taking scissors and glue to make a proof, taking it to the printer, stapling the pamphlet together, then mailing out the 200 copies.'

Membership Renewal Season is here!

For many of our members, the 2026 Membership Renewal season begins October 3rd. Below are a few highlights to remember:

- The deadline for the 2026 Published Membership Directory is January 31, 2026.

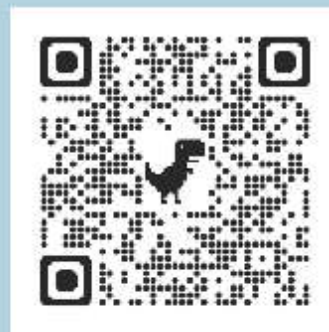
