participating in the following event. Before you decide, please know that I have reserved a room at the White Mule Winery Friday, May 15 at 6:00 for anyone who would like to go to dinner as a group. (You will order off the menu and pay for your own dinners). The White Mule Winery offers their farm raised beef steaks that are cooked over a fire grill as well as other entrée options for those who do not eat beef. The price ranges in price from \$25.00 - \$40PP. The meals include entrée, salad, choice of vegetables, baked potato and roll. Other entrees for those who do not eat steak include chicken and fish entrees and vegetarian choices available with advanced notice. There are also many antique shops in Rosebud and Hermann, MO is not far away.

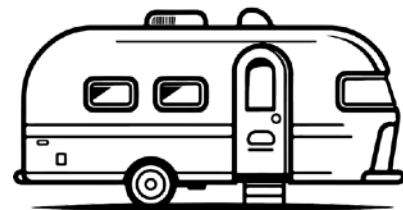
