Pet Policy

Well-behaved pets are welcome at the rally! To help keep everyone—and every pet—safe and comfortable, please follow these guidelines:

All pets must be kept on a **6-foot, non-retractable leash** whenever they are outside your Airstream. Pets are not permitted inside buildings or in outdoor dining areas during meals, with the exception of working service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

During severe weather, pets may accompany their owners into designated shelters. Well-mannered dogs are also welcome to enjoy designated dog parks.

Please be a considerate pet owner by **cleaning up after your pet** and ensuring your pet always wears an identification tag.
