## Update on the Buddy Rally on Lake Murray


The 2nd Annual Buddy Rally on Lake Murray with the North Texas and Oklahoma Airstream Clubs is coming up April 10-12.

## *Co-Editor David's Travelogue*

### **March 2026: Southeastern Connecticut**

Our year-long odyssey on the road planted us in Connecticut right around Labor Day. We headed there after the York International Rally in August, and we're only just now getting ready to head back home.

After unhitching the Airstream in my brother's backyard—and being wonderfully surprised by the 50-amp service he had installed for us in anticipation of our visit (and future visits, we hope!)—we, and the cats, moved into my mother's house 30 miles down I-95, over the Thames (sounds like “tames” not “tems”) and Connecticut Rivers, to Old Saybrook. I felt a little bad not staying in the trailer for a while to visit with my brother, but I'd planned a 2-week 60th birthday trip to Gdansk, Poland for mid-September and we had to acclimate the cats to their designated sitter (Mom!) and her relatively large house. I'm happy to report it all went well, and my brother didn't feel snubbed. After all, we had an entire autumn and winter to spend time together.

I grew up in southeastern CT, and I thought I knew the area pretty well, even though it has been more than 40 years since I lived here. But we took a lot of road trips in this lower-right quadrant of the state, and I was surprised by the number of times I found myself saying, “Oh! I don't remember ever coming down THIS road before!” Yet there's still so much more I want to explore. But it's not like all we did was drive around and see the sights. We visited with my mother and brother and aunt and several cousins, celebrated both Thanksgiving and Christmas with the family, shoveled dozens of inches of snow, and did any number of odd jobs and chores around the house.


Over the next several issues, I'm going to regale you with the myriad of things to see and do in this little corner of this little state—much of which we did, and some of which we didn't get to do.
