Region 4 Survey Results

Thanks to all of you who took the time to share your preferences and feedback during our recent Region 4 survey! The results were reviewed by both your Region 4 leadership team as well as your local club leadership. This feedback will be used to plan future rallies and events and help us as a club deliver the experiences that our members most want.

Some highlights from the feedback we received are:

- 78% of members rank themselves as 4 or 5 on the satisfaction scale (1 to 5). From the comments received, it is apparent that any dissatisfaction is primarily associated with the recent drama at the top of the club, and not over member experience at the local club level.
- 82% of members say they are likely or very likely to recommend the club to others.
- The biggest % of respondents (47%) have been members for 1 to 5 years. Another 27% have been members for 6 to 10 years. This is a strong indication that newer members are more excited about the club and willing to offer their opinions.
- Local, Regional, and International rallies are the biggest service/benefit members use, so it reinforces that this is where we should focus our efforts.
- SEMAC, MAC, and NOVA had the most responses, which makes sense because they are also our largest clubs. We received a fairly proportional response from our membership.
- When it comes to rally activities, a few things show through:
 - Campfires, Music/Jam events, Group Hikes, Local historical sites, Brewery/Winery visits, and Door Prize raffles are popular
 - Golf, Fishing, and Horseback riding are NOT popular.
- When it comes to rally meals, Social Hours and campfire snacks are the most popular, while potluck meals are slightly favored over catered meals (though both are liked). Morning coffee is preferred over a full breakfast. Optional restaurant meals are also enjoyed by a majority.
- For Region rallies, technical presentations, a live band, and Banquet style meals seem to be the favorite activities. While DJ with dancing, and leadership training are NOT of interest to most.
- 98% are willing to travel outside of their home state to attend a rally with their local club!

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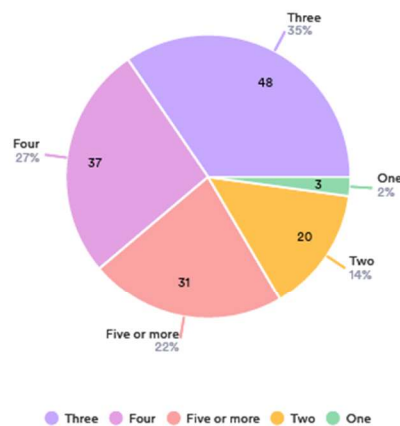
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- 55% of respondents like to attend meet-ups in the off season.
- 57% of respondents would like to see Regional Rally opportunities every year. Another 12% would like multiple Regional Opportunities each year!
- 37% of respondents are willing to host a rally for the first time or would like to learn more!
- 10% of respondents are willing to serve as club leaders now, and another 36% may be willing to do so in the future.
- 55% are active on Facebook, 19% on Instagram, and 19% on Internet Forums
- Members are mostly satisfied with local club communications, but this did vary by club.

How many rallies should your local club offer each year?

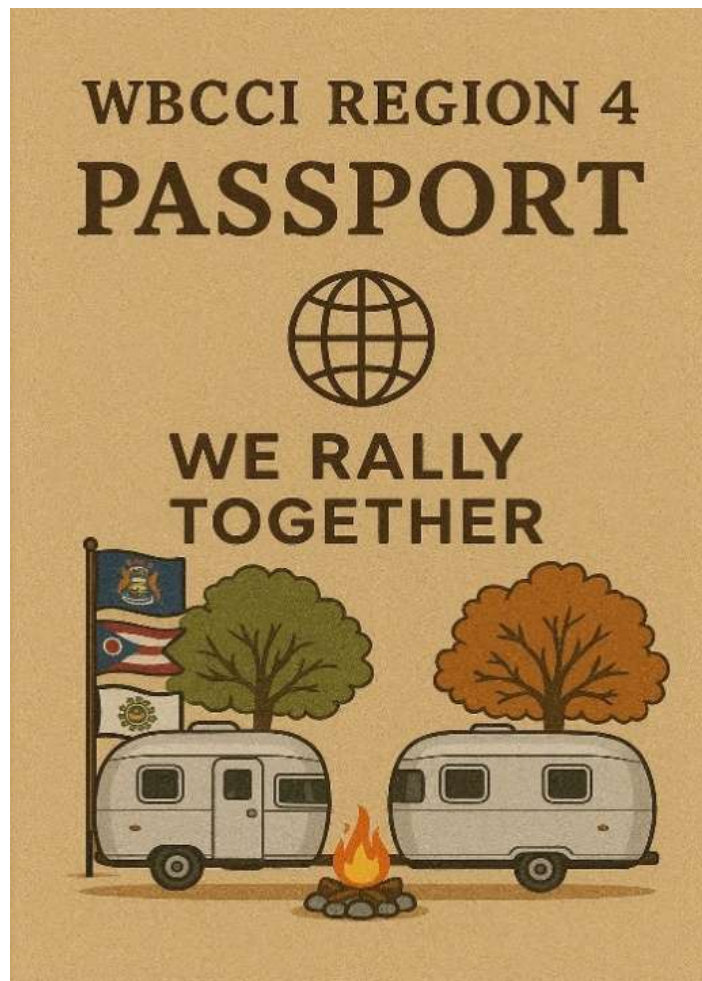

WORDS FROM THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIR

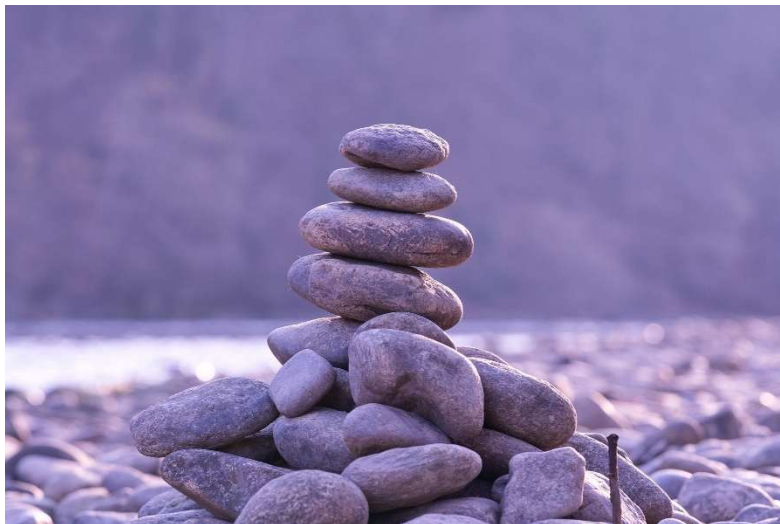

“Gemini” Receives A Power Upgrade at Ramble Trailer Works, NC

There are many ways to camp. You can boondock in the wilderness, pull into a state or national park, hook up at an RV campground, visit a Harvest Host, or settle in at a luxury resort. The options are almost endless. Over the years, we’ve found we enjoy a little bit of everything and that flexibility is exactly what drove us to make a significant upgrade to our 25-foot Airstream Classic “Gemini”.



Choosing Ramble Trailer Works

I’m a handy guy and thought I might upgrade this trailer myself. I reached out to friends in the AS community and surveyed the internet. I then imagined having all the hardware hooked up and then having to spend countless hours with Victron support to get things all working together. Considering this and weighing a number of options, we selected **Ramble Trailer Works** in North Carolina for the job. They’re a new business but they bring real expertise in RV’s including full power builds. (You may know the owner, Chad from his YouTube channel **Chad’s RV Reviews**. They came highly recommended by Brad Driver of **Thirteen Adventures**, whom we had the pleasure of meeting a couple of years back on our way to International in Sedalia. A recommendation from someone you trust goes a long way.

Designing the System

The process started with a conversation with Chad at Ramble. We talked through how we camp, what our power needs were, and what we wanted to accomplish. After that discussion, we landed on the following build:

- 600 watts of solar
- 460 amp-hours of lithium battery storage
- DC-to-DC converter (for charging while driving)
- The full Victron suite, including a 3,000-watt inverter/charger and a Cerbo GX for system monitoring and reporting

We agreed on a price and scheduled a drop-off date that corresponded with our return from our time in Florida. We dropped off the trailer at Ramble and headed back to Michigan. While Ramble had the trailer, I asked they inspect the roof and replace the skylight with a Maxim Airstream skylight. They sent pictures showing sealant wear and recommended resealing.

The Results: Clean, Professional Work

We planned a return trip to North Carolina to pick up the trailer and we were excited to see the results. We were not disappointed. The installation was neat and impressively professional. The interior modifications looked factory-finished, and honestly, the electrical wiring was **better than factory!** Chad spent plenty of time going over the system making sure we understood all the upgrades and how to use them. The system performed exactly as designed and better than we had hoped.



Putting It to the Test

On our way back to Michigan, we took a few extra days to camp and put the new system

through its paces. We never plugged into shore power relying entirely on solar and DC-to-DC charging. The results were outstanding. During our one night stays we never dropped below 85% battery capacity. We used the microwave, lights, water pump, coffee maker and TV without concern for running out the battery.

What This Means for Our Future Camping

This upgrade is a game-changer for us. We fully enjoy and use our **Harvest Host** membership, and many Harvest Hosts locations offer no electrical hookups. With this system, those stays are now fully comfortable and capable. We can even run the AC for a few hours if needed.

We're looking forward to this summer's rallies and planned events with our newly capable Airstream. We'll surely be bringing this rig to the **Airstreams Return to Cadillac Rally in July**, a boondock rally allowing us to test everything right in our own backyard.

Chad really liked our Airstream and did a full review of the rig and upgrades. You can search YouTube for "**Chad's RV reviews**" and "**Ultimate Off-Grid build in this 2005 Airstream Classic 25**" and see the video. You will see "Bring This Floor Plan Back" on the title page.

If you're considering a power upgrade for your trailer, we'd enthusiastically recommend giving **Ramble Trailer Works** a call. They certainly get our stamp of approval.

This rally takes place on private property in the heart of **Cuyahoga Valley National Park**. Since there is no RV camping within the park itself, this rally offers a rare opportunity to explore over 125 miles of hiking trails, 87 miles of Towpath Trail for biking and hiking (dogs allowed on most), more than 100 waterfalls, scenic ledges, a beaver marsh, and abundant wildlife viewing opportunities. The Cuyahoga River Water Trail also provides paddling opportunities for canoes and kayaks.

The Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad runs through the valley, and we hope to reserve a California Zephyr dome car that accommodates up to 60 passengers. If this is not available, attendees May schedule rides independently. Additional details will be shared as plans are finalized.

Camping will be available on a **boondock basis**, with limited access to water and electric, a dump port onsite, and a large communal bonfire pit.

Reservation deadline for the Scenic Railroad excursion is **May 28, 2026**.
