Message from John Deegan ~ Reg 5, President 'A Privilege to Serve'

Madison Rollin' on the River Rally Recap ~

A couple of years ago, three Airstreamers had a conversation! And over twenty months later, out of that grew the first Region 5 Rollin' on the River rally in Madison, Indiana. This little town, voted one of the Best Small Towns in America, was a picture-perfect setting as we camped on Vaughn Drive and Legacy Lot along the riverfront. It was an experience beyond words to finally see this dream come to fruition.



With 45 rigs in attendance, we gathered at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds for overnight staging before caravanning into downtown Madison Wednesday morning. After settling in, we enjoyed a pizza dinner Wednesday evening to officially welcome everyone to the rally. Our gathering place was the reception hall on the second floor of the newly renovated Crystal Beach Aquatic Center. Originally built in 1939, the space featured original stone walls and a fantastic view of the pool on one side and the river (and Airstreams!) on the other. Guest speakers included the Mayor Bob Courtney, Deputy Mayor Tony Steinhardt, III, Visit Madison Executive Director Andrew Forrester and Visit Madison Group Tour Manager J.D. Webster. Rally attendees enjoyed tours of Lanier Mansion, Lanthier Winery and Gardens, Jefferson County Historical Museum & Art Center and a guided Trolley Tour around downtown. An incredible dinner catered by local chef Chris Owens of Chefferguy's Catering on Friday evening was followed by Music in the Park in Bicentennial Park—literally on the other side of the street from where our rigs were parked. Saturday morning brought fog so dense that we could barely see the river, though we definitely heard the fog horns from the river traffic. highlight was an Open House with new model trailers from Woodland Airstream of Lebanon,



IN and from Woodland Airstream of Georgetown, KY. Saturday evening featured winners of the final split the pot and raffle baskets though an ice cream sundae bar compliments of Visit Madison and Chillbilly's Ice Cream Stand was the hit of the night.

During the rally, fund raising efforts benefited the Madison Parks Department and a portion of these funds are earmarked for replacement surfacing of one of the playgrounds damaged by flooding and renovation of Bicentennial Park.

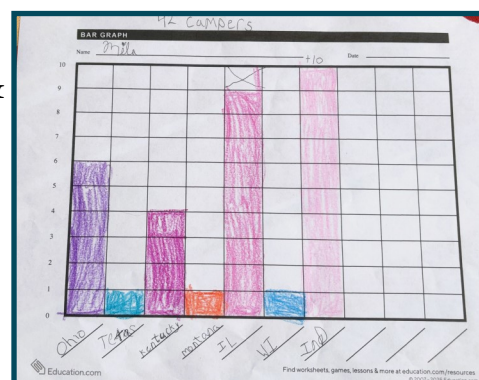

We'll be Rollin' again, so watch for information available soon for Madison Rollin' on the River II in August, 2027!

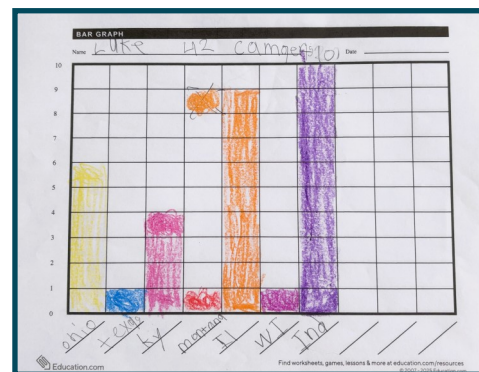

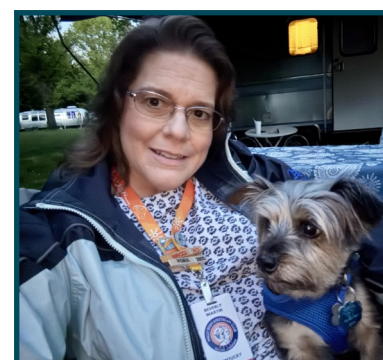

Did you know - a gallon size bag of pop tabs weighs roughly 2.5 lbs.?

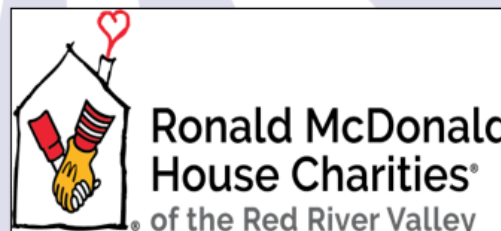
