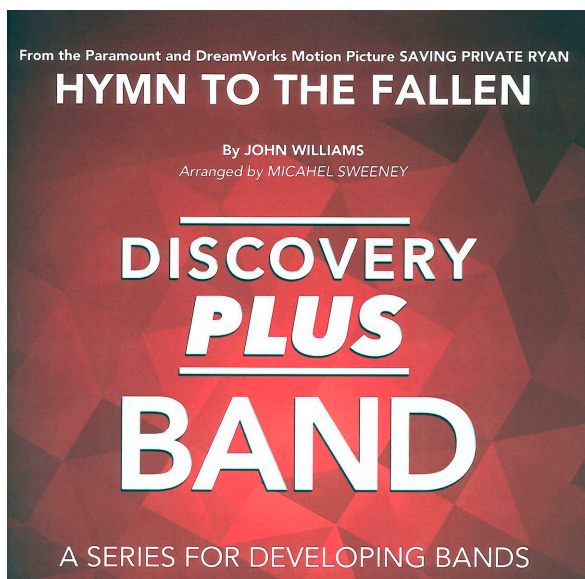

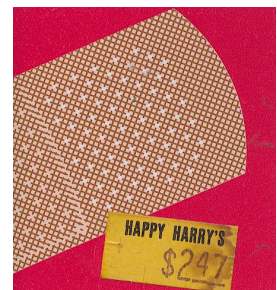

Hello Streaming Musicians,

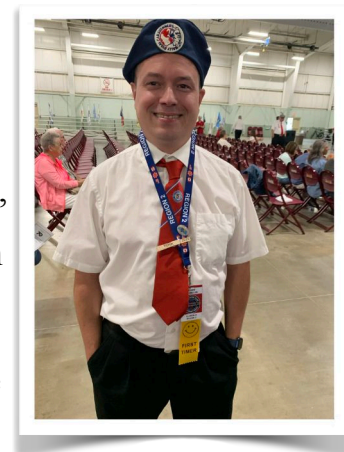
If there's one thing musicians understand, it's that sometimes the best music happens in small ensembles.

Our very first Virtual Happy Hour may have only had a few participants, but what we lacked in numbers we more than made up for in harmony. The conversation flowed easily, the laughter was genuine, and the shared stories reminded me why this group matters. Whether we're gathered around a campfire or a computer screen, there's something special about connecting with people who understand both the rhythm of the road and the rhythm of a good tune.

On a personal note, I owe you a small apology — I completely forgot to specify the time zone in the announcement. That one's on the conductor! Thankfully, those who joined were flexible and gracious, and we still had a great time. Lesson learned: even Presidents need to check the fine print.

Because the first one was such a success, we'll be doing it again in May. Details will be coming soon, and I encourage you to mark your calendars once they're announced. If we purchase between 7 and 10, they are \$84 plus shipping, handling and tax.

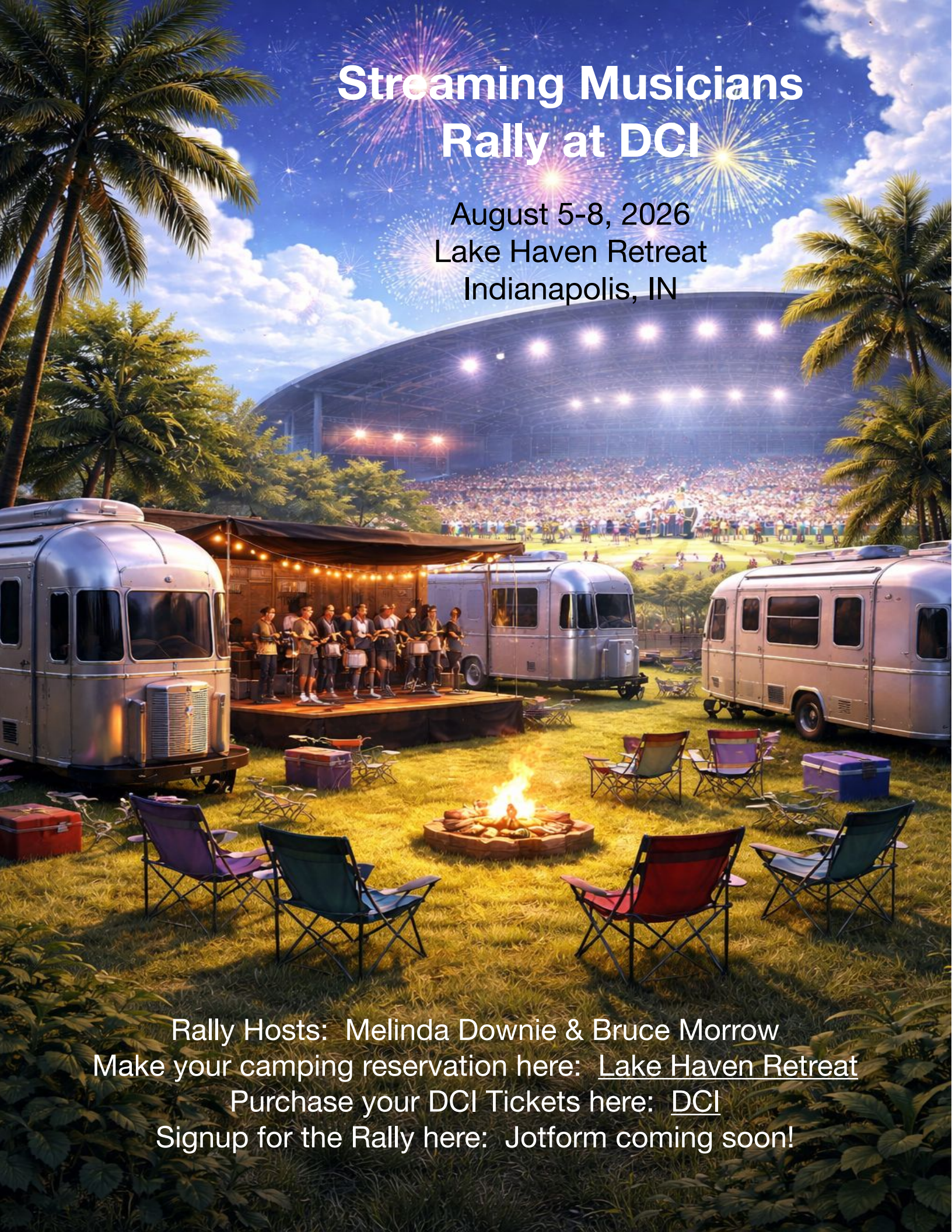

## For Bluegrass Fans – go to Gettysburg

The May Festival always sells out. There are a few tickets and camping spots available. The Keystone Airstream Club tells us:

“The festival is a 5-day camping package with 2 festival tickets included for \$568.50

They have other hook up options elsewhere in the park but if you want to be with us, ask for the Safari Post Area. The posts are 30amp with water. There is a honey truck available. Each post serves 4 rigs. The area is grass. Posts 10-12 are right across the street from what we had reserved.

For reference, Keystone is on posts 1 and 2.

To get in that area you MUST book a Tuesday through Sunday reservation...that’s just how the festival works.

It can get muddy, so come prepared...and depending where you are on the post (they are first come first serve), you may need an extension cord.

Also, as with most Bluegrass festivals, you can set up chairs and leave them out all festival. There is an open area in front of the stage and a huge tent up on a hill for shelter that also has great views of the stage. I recommend bringing a set of chairs you don’t mind leaving out and a couple garbage bags to keep them dry if it rains.”
