We sincerely appreciate your help.



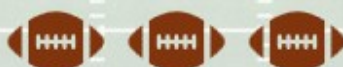

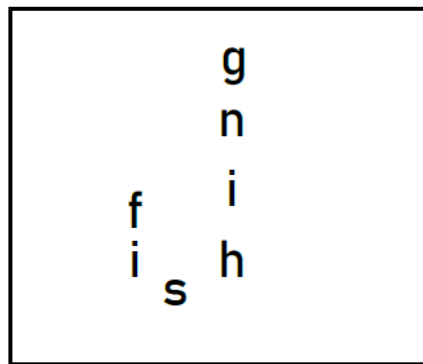
