12 Things to Keep in your RV Junk Drawer

No matter how organized you are, nearly every home—and RV—has a catch-all space. While we often call it a “junk drawer,” it’s really more of a *utility drawer*: a place for small, handy items that don’t quite belong anywhere else. The key is to keep it simple—stick to one dedicated space so you can actually find what you need when you need it. If a drawer isn’t available, a small plastic shoebox or tackle box works just as well and adds portability.

Because space is limited in an RV, choose items that are compact, lightweight, and versatile. Here are 12 essentials to consider:

1. **Lighters and matches** – For stoves, campfires, or helping out a neighbor.
2. **Small flashlights and batteries** – Always useful on dark nights; keep a few extras handy.
3. **Pens and Sharpies** – For paperwork, notes, and labeling.
4. **Lubricant** – A small can of WD-40 or similar keeps doors, hinges, and hitch parts moving smoothly.
5. **Command hooks** – Great for quick storage fixes; keep extra adhesive strips too.
6. **Bungees, gear ties, or zip ties** – Essential for securing loose items or quick repairs.
7. **Adhesive felt pads** – Perfect for stopping rattles, leveling furniture, or preventing sliding.
8. **Scissors and a utility knife** – Everyday must-haves for everything from food prep to quick fixes.
9. **Super glue or marine adhesive** – Small but invaluable for quick repairs.
10. **Post-it Notes** – Handy for reminders and messages.
11. **Multi-tool** – A compact alternative to a full toolbox for small jobs.
12. **Screen wipes and microfiber cloths** – Keep screens and glasses clean on the go.

Leave bulkier or messier items—like full toolkits or duct tape—in a separate storage area. Keeping your utility drawer streamlined ensures it stays useful rather than cluttered.
