

Refrigerator Odor

I have just returned from a trip and want to shut down my refrigerator. How can I prevent mildew and odors from building up inside my refrigerator/freezer?

First defrost the refrigerator; then wash inside with a warm water solution of mild detergent or baking soda; rinse; wipe dry as soon as possible. Now get your local newspaper and pull out a section (I like to use the sports section) and put one page on each shelf, including the freezer compartment. Once this has been completed close the doors. Before turning your refrigerator on prior to your next trip just remove the papers. It will be dry and odor free.

Also newspaper is great for laying over damp spots in carpet to absorb moisture.

Crumpled up newspaper placed inside shoes and boots will also help absorb moisture and eliminate odors.
