## **Tire Feedback**

A fellow Airstreamer responded to a previous article in the Airstream Tech Help Group column concerning tire options. He wanted to share that there is a Goodyear15" LT tire available and one he has been using on his trailer. The tire he is using is a 15" LT tire (Goodyear Wrangler LT215/75R15). It is an 8 Ply load range D, Max Load 2,095 lbs ,65 psi tire. This is a good alternative for those with small trailers that can't ft the 16" LT Michelin, 10 Ply., load range E, 80 PSI max tire or they are not wanting to buy new rims. Either tire would be a good upgrade option for an SP/ST rated tire. Always keep in mind when changing tires or rims, that they need to meet the weight ratings for your trailer. This even involves the valve stem meeting the psi rating of the tire and proper torque for the rims.

Thanks for the info. We are passing it on for those that it might help out. We still believe that if you can ft the 16" Michelin into the wheel well of your trailer that it is one of the better options available. Ray has the 16" Michelins on his 20' Safari and they are performing well for him. Please keep the feedback and suggestions coming.
