

Window Gaskets Sticking

Question: Window Gaskets Sticking: Is there a compound I should treat the window gaskets with from time to time to reduce the window glass from sticking when you try to open them?

Answer: Yes! Get some 303 from a good auto parts supply store or an RV store. Apply this to all of your gaskets (windows, door compartments, fan shroud seals, etc.) with a folded up paper towel every year when you go thru your get ready to go camping maintenance. This will protect the seals and keep them clean and pliable. If the seals are too dirty, wash them with soap and water and dry them before using the 303.

In addition, when winterizing put about ¼ inch of vegetable oil in your toilet to keep the toilet seal from hardening over the winter. About 20 years ago, I had a leaking toilet seal so I purchased a new one to replace it. I started with the vegetable oil, softened the seal and to this day, have never used the new seal.
